Observations from the parable (Matthew 18:21-35)

- 1. God will settle accounts
- 2. God is both just and merciful
- 3. God desires to forgive ALL debts
- 4. God's forgiveness is a free gift offered to all
- 5. God paid our debt himself
- 6. We are forgiven forgivers

Two inseparable words. Each necessitates the other. Matthew 6:14-15

- 7. Forgiveness is a continuous choice to release the debt and the person to God
- 8. Forgiveness is based on grace

Ephesians 4:32 And be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you.

- 9. Don't confuse interpersonal and institutional forgiveness
 Romans 12:19-13:4
- 10. Don't confuse forgiveness and trust
- 11. Don't confuse forgiveness and forgetfulness
 Hebrews 10:16-22
- 12. Don't confuse forgiveness and grief
- 13. Forgiveness is hard
- 14. The ability to forgive comes from the ongoing experience of being forgiven Luke 7:36-50
- 15. Seek reconciliation where possible

The parable is tied to the context of correcting and reconciling one another (Matthew 18:15-20)
