Principles for courtship with oneness as the goal:

1. Repentance, renewing, prayer, worship and fellowship

Ephesians 4:17 This I say therefore, and affirm together with the Lord, that you walk no longer just as the Gentiles also walk, in the futility of their mind,

- being darkened in their understanding, excluded from the life of God, because of the ignorance that is in them, because of the hardness of their heart;
- ¹⁹ and they, having become callous, have given themselves over to sensuality, for the practice of every kind of impurity with greediness.
- ²⁰ But you did not learn Christ in this way,
- ²¹ if indeed you have heard Him and have been taught in Him, just as truth is in Jesus,
- that, in reference to your former manner of life, you lay aside the old self, which is being corrupted in accordance with the lusts of deceit,
- ²³ and that you be renewed in the spirit of your mind,
- ²⁴ and put on the new self, which in *the likeness of* God has been created in righteousness and holiness of the truth.

Galatians 5:13 For you were called to freedom, brethren; only *do* not *turn* your freedom into an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another.

- ¹⁴ For the whole Law is fulfilled in one word, in the statement, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself."
- ¹⁵ But if you bite and devour one another, take care lest you be consumed by one another.
- ¹⁶ But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not carry out the desire of the flesh.
- ¹⁷ For the flesh sets its desire against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; for these are in opposition to one another, so that you may not do the things that you please.
- ¹⁸ But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the Law.
- ¹⁹ Now the deeds of the flesh are evident, which are: immorality, impurity, sensuality,

2. Make sure you're ready to marry

Song of Solomon 8:8 "We have a little sister, And she has no breasts; What shall we do for our sister On the day when she is spoken for?

- ⁹ "If she is a wall, We shall build on her a battlement of silver; But if she is a door, We shall barricade her with planks of cedar."
- ¹⁰ "I was a wall, and my breasts were like towers; Then I became in his eyes as one who finds peace.

3. Court only a Christian

2 Corinthians 6:14 Do not be bound together with unbelievers; for what partnership have righteousness and lawlessness, or what fellowship has light with darkness?

- ¹⁵ Or what harmony has Christ with Belial, or what has a believer in common with an unbeliever?
- ¹⁶ Or what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For we are the temple of the living God; just as God said, "I will dwell in them and walk among them; And I will be their God, and they shall be My people.
- ¹⁷ "Therefore, come out from their midst and be separate," says the Lord. "And do not touch what is unclean; And I will welcome you.
- ¹⁸ "And I will be a father to you, And you shall be sons and daughters to Me," Says the Lord Almighty.
- 4. Court only a Christian you'd marry (Example lists for ladies: Proverbs; Ephesians 5; 1 and 2 Timothy; for men: Proverbs 31; 1 Peter 3)

5. Watch, pray and seek council

Philippians 1:9 And this I pray, that your love may abound still more and more in real knowledge and all discernment,

Proverbs 15:22 Without consultation, plans are frustrated, But with many counselors they succeed.

6. Ask her parent's permission to court

Deuteronomy 5:16 'Honor your father and your mother,...

7. Set intimacy boundaries

- **1 Corinthians 6:9** Or do you not know that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived; neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor homosexuals,
- ¹⁰ nor thieves, nor *the* covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor swindlers, shall inherit the kingdom of God.
- ¹¹ And such were some of you; but you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, and in the Spirit of our God.
- ¹² All things are lawful for me, but not all things are profitable. All things are lawful for me, but I will not be mastered by anything.
- ¹³ Food is for the stomach, and the stomach is for food; but God will do away with both of them. Yet the body is not for immorality, but for the Lord; and the Lord is for the body.
- ¹⁴ Now God has not only raised the Lord, but will also raise us up through His power.
- ¹⁵ Do you not know that your bodies are members of Christ? Shall I then take away the members of Christ and make them members of a harlot? May it never be!
- ¹⁶ Or do you not know that the one who joins himself to a harlot is one body *with her*? For He says, "The two will become one flesh."
- ¹⁷ But the one who joins himself to the Lord is one spirit with Him.
- ¹⁸ Flee immorality. Every *other* sin that a man commits is outside the body, but the immoral man sins against his own body.
- ¹⁹ Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own?
- ²⁰ For you have been bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body.
- 1 Corinthians 10:8 Nor let us act immorally, as some of them did, and twenty-three thousand fell in one day.

Galatians 5:19 Now the deeds of the flesh are evident, which are: immorality, impurity, sensuality,

- ²⁰ idolatry, sorcery, enmities, strife, jealousy, outbursts of anger, disputes, dissensions, factions,
- ²¹ envying, drunkenness, carousing, and things like these, of which I forewarn you just as I have forewarned you that those who practice such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.

Ephesians 5:3 But do not let immorality or any impurity or greed even be named among you, as is proper among saints;

- ⁴ and *there must be no* filthiness and silly talk, or coarse jesting, which are not fitting, but rather giving of thanks.
- ⁵ For this you know with certainty, that no immoral or impure person or covetous man, who is an idolater, has an inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and God.
- ⁶ Let no one deceive you with empty words, for because of these things the wrath of God comes upon the sons of disobedience.

Colossians 3:5 Therefore consider the members of your earthly body as dead to immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and greed, which amounts to idolatry.

⁶ For it is on account of these things that the wrath of God will come,

- **1 Thessalonians 4:3** For this is the will of God, your sanctification; *that is*, that you abstain from sexual immorality:
- ⁴ that each of you know how to possess his own vessel in sanctification and honor.
- ⁵ not in lustful passion, like the Gentiles who do not know God;
- ⁶ and that no man transgress and defraud his brother in the matter because the Lord is *the* avenger in all these things, just as we also told you before and solemnly warned *you*.
- ⁷ For God has not called us for the purpose of impurity, but in sanctification.
- ⁸ Consequently, he who rejects this is not rejecting man but the God who gives His Holy Spirit to you.

Hebrews 13:4 Let marriage be held in honor among all, and let the marriage bed be undefiled; for fornicators and adulterers God will judge.

8. Do only what you want your future wife to do

9. Do only what you want done to your future wife and your daughter

The lady you're courting is someone's future wife

The lady you're courting is someone's daughter

10. Do only what grows future trust in your marriage.

If the one you're courting becomes your future wife you are now teaching her about your character, sexual convictions and how much she can trust you.

11. Treat her as God's daughter. The lady you're courting is God's daughter.

1 Timothy 5:2 (*treat*) the younger women as sisters, in all purity.

12. Avoid seclusion

Romans 13:14 But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh in regard to its lusts.

13. Stay accountable to some partners

Proverbs 12:15 The way of a fool is right in his own eyes, But a wise man is he who listens to counsel.

14. Focus on friendship and ministry

1 Corinthians 7:35 And this I say for your own benefit; not to put a restraint upon you, but to promote what is seemly, and *to secure* undistracted devotion to the Lord.

15. Get to know each other's families

16. Honor each other and God. The key to courtship is worship and honor.
