Matthew 28:1 Now after the Sabbath, as it began to dawn toward the first *day* of the week, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary came to look at the grave.

- ² And behold, a severe earthquake had occurred, for an angel of the Lord descended from heaven and came and rolled away the stone and sat upon it.
- ³ And his appearance was like lightning, and his garment as white as snow:
- ⁴ and the guards shook for fear of him, and became like dead men.
- ⁵ And the angel answered and said to the women, "Do not be afraid; for I know that you are looking for Jesus who has been crucified.
- ⁶ "He is not here, for He has risen, just as He said. Come, see the place where He was lying.
- ⁷ "And go quickly and tell His disciples that He has risen from the dead; and behold, He is going before you into Galilee, there you will see Him; behold, I have told you."
- ⁸ And they departed quickly from the tomb with fear and great joy and ran to report it to His disciples.

John 20:1 Now on the first *day* of the week Mary Magdalene came early to the tomb, while it was still dark, and saw the stone *already* taken away from the tomb.

- ² And so she ran and came to Simon Peter, and to the other disciple whom Jesus loved, and said to them, "They have taken away the Lord out of the tomb, and we do not know where they have laid Him."
- ³ Peter therefore went forth, and the other disciple, and they were going to the tomb.
- And the two were running together; and the other disciple ran ahead faster than Peter, and came to the tomb first;
- ⁵ and stooping and looking in, he saw the linen wrappings lying *there*; but he did not go in.
- ⁶ Simon Peter therefore also came, following him, and entered the tomb; and he beheld the linen wrappings lying there,
- ⁷ and the face-cloth, which had been on His head, not lying with the linen wrappings, but rolled up in a place by itself.
- ⁸ So the other disciple who had first come to the tomb entered then also, and he saw and believed.
- ⁹ For as yet they did not understand the Scripture, that He must rise again from the dead.
- ¹⁰ So the disciples went away again to their own homes.
- ¹¹ But Mary was standing outside the tomb weeping; and so, as she wept, she stooped and looked into the tomb;
- ¹² and she beheld two angels in white sitting, one at the head, and one at the feet, where the body of Jesus had been lying.
- And they said to her, "Woman, why are you weeping?" She said to them, "Because they have taken away my Lord, and I do not know where they have laid Him."
- ¹⁴ When she had said this, she turned around, and beheld Jesus standing *there*, and did not know that it was Jesus.
- ¹⁵ Jesus said to her, "Woman, why are you weeping? Whom are you seeking?" Supposing Him to be the gardener, she said to Him, "Sir, if you have carried Him away, tell me where you have laid Him, and I will take Him away."
- ¹⁶ Jesus said to her, "Mary!" She turned and said to Him in Hebrew, "Rabboni!" (which means, Teacher).
- ¹⁷ Jesus said to her, "Stop clinging to Me, for I have not yet ascended to the Father; but go to My brethren, and say to them, 'I ascend to My Father and your Father, and My God and your God.'"
- ¹⁸ Mary Magdalene came, announcing to the disciples, "I have seen the Lord," and *that* He had said these things to her.

Matthew 28:9 And behold, Jesus met them and greeted them. And they came up and took hold of His feet and worshiped Him.

- ¹⁰ Then Jesus said to them, "Do not be afraid; go and take word to My brethren to leave for Galilee, and there they shall see Me."
- ¹¹ Now while they were on their way, behold, some of the guard came into the city and reported to the chief priests all that had happened.
- And when they had assembled with the elders and counseled together, they gave a large sum of money to the soldiers,
- ¹³ and said, "You are to say, 'His disciples came by night and stole Him away while we were asleep.'
- ¹⁴ "And if this should come to the governor's ears, we will win him over and keep you out of trouble."
- ¹⁵ And they took the money and did as they had been instructed; and this story was widely spread among the Jews, *and is* to this day.

John 20:19 When therefore it was evening, on that day, the first day of the week, and when the doors were shut where the disciples were, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood in their midst, and said to them, "Peace be with you."

And when He had said this, He showed them both His hands and His side. The disciples therefore rejoiced when they saw the Lord.
