## 9. L to God's word

- <sup>19</sup> *This* you know, my beloved brethren. But let everyone be quick to hear, slow to speak *and* slow to anger;
- <sup>20</sup> for the anger of man does not achieve the righteousness of God.
- <sup>21</sup> Therefore putting aside all filthiness and *all* that remains of wickedness, in humility receive the word implanted, which is able to save your souls.

## 10. L God's word

- <sup>22</sup> But prove yourselves doers of the word, and not merely hearers who delude themselves.
- <sup>23</sup> For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man who looks at his natural face in a mirror;
- <sup>24</sup> for *once* he has looked at himself and gone away, he has immediately forgotten what kind of person he was.
- <sup>25</sup> But one who looks intently at the perfect law, the *law* of liberty, and abides by it, not having become a forgetful hearer but an effectual doer, this man shall be blessed in what he does.
