## **How Do You Do That?**

**John 13:12** And so when He had washed their feet, and taken His garments, and reclined at the table again, He said to them, "Do you know what I have done to you?

- <sup>13</sup> "You call Me Teacher and Lord; and you are right, for so I am.
- <sup>14</sup> "If I then, the Lord and the Teacher, washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet.
- <sup>15</sup> "For I gave you an example that you also should do as I did to you.
- <sup>16</sup> "Truly, truly, I say to you, a slave is not greater than his master; neither *is* one who is sent greater than the one who sent him.
- <sup>17</sup> "If you know these things, you are blessed if you do them.

## **John 17:17** "Sanctify them in the truth; Thy word is truth.

- <sup>18</sup> "As Thou didst send Me into the world, I also have sent them into the world.
- <sup>19</sup> "And for their sakes I sanctify Myself, that they themselves also may be sanctified in truth.
- <sup>20</sup> "I do not ask in behalf of these alone, but for those also who believe in Me through their word;
- <sup>21</sup> that they may all be one; even as Thou, Father, *art* in Me, and I in Thee, that they also may be in Us; that the world may believe that Thou didst send Me.
- <sup>22</sup> "And the glory which Thou hast given Me I have given to them; that they may be one, just as We are one:
- <sup>23</sup> I in them, and Thou in Me, that they may be perfected in unity, that the world may know that Thou didst send Me, and didst love them, even as Thou didst love Me.

## **Acts 2:40** And with many other words he solemnly testified and kept on exhorting them, saying, "Be saved from this perverse generation!"

- <sup>41</sup> So then, those who had received his word were baptized; and there were added that day about three thousand souls.
- <sup>42</sup> And they were continually devoting themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.
- <sup>43</sup> And everyone kept feeling a sense of awe; and many wonders and signs were taking place through the apostles.
- <sup>44</sup> And all those who had believed were together, and had all things in common;
- <sup>45</sup> and they *began* selling their property and possessions, and were sharing them with all, as anyone might have need.
- <sup>46</sup> And day by day continuing with one mind in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they were taking their meals together with gladness and sincerity of heart,
- <sup>47</sup> praising God, and having favor with all the people. And the Lord was adding to their number day by day those who were being saved.

**Ephesians 4:1** I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, entreat you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called,

- <sup>2</sup> with all humility and gentleness, with patience, showing forbearance to one another in love,
- <sup>3</sup> being diligent to preserve the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.
- <sup>4</sup> There is one body and one Spirit, just as also you were called in one hope of your calling;
- <sup>5</sup> one Lord, one faith, one baptism,
- <sup>6</sup> one God and Father of all who is over all and through all and in all.
- <sup>7</sup> But to each one of us grace was given according to the measure of Christ's gift.

- <sup>8</sup> Therefore it says, "When He ascended on high, He led captive a host of captives, And He gave gifts to men."
- <sup>9</sup> (Now this *expression*, "He ascended," what does it mean except that He also had descended into the lower parts of the earth?
- <sup>10</sup> He who descended is Himself also He who ascended far above all the heavens, that He might fill all things.)
- <sup>11</sup> And He gave some *as* apostles, and some *as* prophets, and some *as* evangelists, and some *as* pastors and teachers,
- <sup>12</sup> for the equipping of the saints for the work of service, to the building up of the body of Christ;
- <sup>13</sup> until we all attain to the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a mature man, to the measure of the stature which belongs to the fulness of Christ.
- <sup>14</sup> As a result, we are no longer to be children, tossed here and there by waves, and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, by craftiness in deceitful scheming;
- 15 but speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in all aspects into Him, who is the head, even Christ,
- <sup>16</sup> from whom the whole body, being fitted and held together by that which every joint supplies, according to the proper working of each individual part, causes the growth of the body for the building up

of itself in love.

Philippians 1:27 Only conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the good of Christ; so that whether I

**Philippians 1:27** Only conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ; so that whether I come and see you or remain absent, I may hear of you that you are standing firm in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel;

- <sup>28</sup> in no way alarmed by *your* opponents-- which is a sign of destruction for them, but of salvation for you, and that *too*, from God.
- <sup>29</sup> For to you it has been granted for Christ's sake, not only to believe in Him, but also to suffer for His sake.
- <sup>30</sup> experiencing the same conflict which you saw in me, and now hear to be in me.
- **2:1** If therefore there is any encouragement in Christ, if there is any consolation of love, if there is any fellowship of the Spirit, if any affection and compassion,
- <sup>2</sup> make my joy complete by being of the same mind, maintaining the same love, united in spirit, intent on one purpose.
- <sup>3</sup> Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind let each of you regard one another as more important than himself;
- <sup>4</sup> do not *merely* look out for your own personal interests, but also for the interests of others.
- <sup>5</sup> Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus,

**Colossians 3:11** ...there is no *distinction between* Greek and Jew, circumcised and uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave and freeman, but Christ is all, and in all.

- <sup>12</sup> And so, as those who have been chosen of God, holy and beloved, put on a heart of compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience;
- <sup>13</sup> bearing with one another, and forgiving each other, whoever has a complaint against anyone; just as the Lord forgave you, so also should you.
- <sup>14</sup> And beyond all these things *put on* love, which is the perfect bond of unity.
- <sup>15</sup> And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body; and be thankful.
- <sup>16</sup> Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you, with all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another with psalms *and* hymns *and* spiritual songs, singing with thankfulness in your hearts to God.
- <sup>17</sup> And whatever you do in word or deed, *do* all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through Him to God the Father.

**Hebrews 10:19** Since therefore, brethren, we have confidence to enter the holy place by the blood of Jesus.

- <sup>20</sup> by a new and living way which He inaugurated for us through the veil, that is, His flesh,
- <sup>21</sup> and since we have a great priest over the house of God,
- <sup>22</sup> let us draw near with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled *clean* from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.
- <sup>23</sup> Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful;
- <sup>24</sup> and let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds,
- <sup>25</sup> not forsaking our own assembling together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging *one another*, and all the more, as you see the day drawing near.
- <sup>26</sup> For if we go on sinning willfully after receiving the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins,
- <sup>27</sup> but a certain terrifying expectation of judgment, and the fury of a fire which will consume the adversaries.
- **1 John 4:7** Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God.
- <sup>8</sup> The one who does not love does not know God, for God is love.
- <sup>9</sup> By this the love of God was manifested in us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world so that we might live through Him.
- <sup>10</sup> In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son *to be* the propitiation for our sins.
- <sup>11</sup> Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another.
- <sup>12</sup> No one has beheld God at any time; if we love one another, God abides in us, and His love is perfected in us.
