Aspiration 1 sexual purity

Must haves for growth in sexual purity:

1. a supreme desire to live set apart to <u>Jesus</u>

³ For this is the will of God, your sanctification;

2. discipline

that is, that you abstain from sexual immorality;

3. wisdom

4 that each of you know how to possess his own vessel

4. honor

in sanctification and honor,

5. rebellion to <u>lustful</u> thoughts

⁵ not in lustful passion,

6. intimate knowledge of <u>God</u>

like the Gentiles who do not know God;

7. integrity

⁶ and that no man transgress and defraud his brother in the matter

8. God's warnings

because the Lord is the avenger in all these things, just as we also told you before and solemnly warned you.

9. God's calling

⁷ For God has not called us for the purpose of impurity, but in sanctification.

10. intimacy with **God**

⁸ Consequently, he who rejects *this* is not rejecting man but the God who gives His Holy Spirit to you.

- **1 Corinthians 6:9** Or do you not know that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived; neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor homosexuals,
- ¹⁰ nor thieves, nor the covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor swindlers, shall inherit the kingdom of God.
- ¹¹ And such were some of you; but you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, and in the Spirit of our God.
- ¹² All things are lawful for me, but not all things are profitable. All things are lawful for me, but I will not be mastered by anything.
- ¹³ Food is for the stomach, and the stomach is for food; but God will do away with both of them. Yet the body is not for immorality, but for the Lord; and the Lord is for the body.
- ¹⁴ Now God has not only raised the Lord, but will also raise us up through His power.
- ¹⁵ Do you not know that your bodies are members of Christ? Shall I then take away the members of Christ and make them members of a harlot? May it never be!
- ¹⁶ Or do you not know that the one who joins himself to a harlot is one body *with her*? For He says, "The two will become one flesh."
- ¹⁷ But the one who joins himself to the Lord is one spirit *with Him*.
- ¹⁸ Flee immorality. Every *other* sin that a man commits is outside the body, but the immoral man sins against his own body.
- ¹⁹ Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own?
- ²⁰ For you have been bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body.
- 7:1 Now concerning the things about which you wrote, it is good for a man not to touch a woman.
- ² But because of immoralities, let each man have his own wife, and let each woman have her own husband.
- ³ Let the husband fulfill his duty to his wife, and likewise also the wife to her husband.
- ⁴ The wife does not have authority over her own body, but the husband *does*; and likewise also the husband does not have authority over his own body, but the wife *does*.
- ⁵ Stop depriving one another, except by agreement for a time that you may devote yourselves to prayer, and come together again lest Satan tempt you because of your lack of self-control.

Ephesians 5:1 Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children;

- ² and walk in love, just as Christ also loved you, and gave Himself up for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God as a fragrant aroma.
- ³ But do not let immorality or any impurity or greed even be named among you, as is proper among saints;
- ⁴ and there must be no filthiness and silly talk, or coarse jesting, which are not fitting, but rather giving of thanks.
- ⁵ For this you know with certainty, that no immoral or impure person or covetous man, who is an idolater, has an inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and God.
- ⁶ Let no one deceive you with empty words, for because of these things the wrath of God comes upon the sons of disobedience.
- ⁷ Therefore do not be partakers with them;
- ⁸ for you were formerly darkness, but now you are light in the Lord; walk as children of light
- ⁹ (for the fruit of the light *consists* in all goodness and righteousness and truth).
- ¹⁰ trying to learn what is pleasing to the Lord.
- ¹¹ And do not participate in the unfruitful deeds of darkness, but instead even expose them;
- ¹² for it is disgraceful even to speak of the things which are done by them in secret.
- ¹³ But all things become visible when they are exposed by the light, for everything that becomes visible is light.
- ¹⁴ For this reason it says, "Awake, sleeper, And arise from the dead, And Christ will shine on you."

Ephesians 5:25 Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her;

- ²⁶ that He might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word,
- ²⁷ that He might present to Himself the church in all her glory, having no spot or wrinkle or any such thing; but that she should be holy and blameless.
- ²⁸ So husbands ought also to love their own wives as their own bodies. He who loves his own wife loves himself;
- ²⁹ for no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as Christ also *does* the church,
- ³⁰ because we are members of His body.
- ³¹ For this cause a man shall leave his father and mother, and shall cleave to his wife; and the two shall become one flesh.
- ³² This mystery is great; but I am speaking with reference to Christ and the church.
