James 3:13 Who among you is wise and understanding? Let him show by his good behavior his deeds in the gentleness of wisdom.

¹⁴ But if you have bitter jealousy and selfish ambition in your heart, do not be arrogant and *so* lie against the truth.

¹⁵ This wisdom is not that which comes down from above, but is earthly, natural, demonic.

¹⁶ For where jealousy and selfish ambition exist, there is disorder and every evil thing.

¹⁷ But the wisdom from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, reasonable, full of mercy and good fruits, unwavering, without hypocrisy.

¹⁸ And the seed whose fruit is righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace.

Proverbs 3:13 How blessed is the man who finds wisdom,

And the man who gains understanding.

¹⁴ For its profit is better than the profit of silver,

And its gain than fine gold.

¹⁵ She is more precious than jewels;

And nothing you desire compares with her.

¹⁶ Long life is in her right hand;

In her left hand are riches and honor.

¹⁷ Her ways are pleasant ways,

And all her paths are peace.

¹⁸ She is a tree of life to those who take hold of her,

And happy are all who hold her fast.

How to Become Wise 1 Corinthians 2:6 – 3:8

1. Study the wisdom of the <u>a</u>

1 Corinthians 2:6 Yet we do speak wisdom among those who are mature; a wisdom, however, not of this age, nor of the rulers of this age, who are passing away;

⁷ but we speak God's wisdom in a mystery, the hidden *wisdom*, which God predestined before the ages to our glory;

⁸ the wisdom which none of the rulers of this age has understood; for if they had understood it, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory;

⁹ but just as it is written, "Things which eye has not seen and ear has not heard, And *which* have not entered the heart of man, All that God has prepared for those who love Him."

2. As you study listen for <u>G</u> to speak to you

¹⁰ For to us God revealed *them* through the Spirit; for the Spirit searches all things, even the depths of God.

¹¹ For who among men knows the *thoughts* of a man except the spirit of the man, which is in him? Even so the *thoughts* of God no one knows except the Spirit of God.

¹² Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things freely given to us by God,

¹³ which things we also speak, not in words taught by human wisdom, but in those taught by the Spirit, combining spiritual *thoughts* with spiritual *words*.

Note 1 Corinthians 3:16 Do you not know that you are a temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?

3. Denounce the old <u>t</u> patterns

¹⁴ But a natural man does not accept the things of the Spirit of God; for they are foolishness to him, and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually appraised.

4. Evaluate <u>e</u> (there are many schemes out there)

¹⁵ But he who is spiritual appraises all things,

5. Don't worry about the <u>o</u> of others

yet he himself is appraised by no man.

6. Study J

¹⁶ For who has known the mind of the Lord, that he should instruct Him? But we have the mind of Christ.

An illustration

1 Corinthians **3:1** And I, brethren, could not speak to you as to spiritual men, but as to men of flesh, as to babes in Christ.

² I gave you milk to drink, not solid food; for you were not yet able *to receive it*. Indeed, even now you are not yet able,

³ for you are still fleshly. For since there is jealousy and strife among you, are you not fleshly, and are you not walking like mere men?

⁴ For when one says, "I am of Paul," and another, "I am of Apollos," are you not *mere* men?

⁵ What then is Apollos? And what is Paul? Servants through whom you believed, even as the Lord gave *opportunity* to each one.

⁶ I planted, Apollos watered, but God was causing the growth.

⁷ So then neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but God who causes the growth.

⁸ Now he who plants and he who waters are one; but each will receive his own reward according to his own labor.

How to Retire Wealthy 1 Corinthians 3:9 – 3:15

1. Build your investment home <u>o</u> Jesus

1 Corinthians 3:9 For we are God's fellow workers; you are God's field, God's building.

¹⁰ According to the grace of God which was given to me, as a wise master builder I laid a foundation,

and another is building upon it. But let each man be careful how he builds upon it.

¹¹ For no man can lay a foundation other than the one which is laid, which is Jesus Christ.

2. Build your investment home <u>f</u> Jesus

¹² Now if any man builds upon the foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw, ¹³ each man's work will become evident; for the day will show it, because it is *to be* revealed with fire; and the fire itself will test the quality of each man's work.

¹⁴ If any man's work which he has built upon it remains, he shall receive a reward.

¹⁵ If any man's work is burned up, he shall suffer loss; but he himself shall be saved, yet so as through fire.

Note 1 Corinthians 4:1 Let a man regard us in this manner, as servants of Christ, and stewards of the mysteries of God.

² In this case, moreover, it is required of stewards that one be found trustworthy.

³ But to me it is a very small thing that I should be examined by you, or by *any* human court; in fact, I do not even examine myself.

⁴ For I am conscious of nothing against myself, yet I am not by this acquitted; but the one who examines me is the Lord.

⁵ Therefore do not go on passing judgment before the time, *but wait* until the Lord comes who will both bring to light the things hidden in the darkness and disclose the motives of *men's* hearts; and then each man's praise will come to him from God.
