# Why was my Brother Taken and What Can We Do?

## Q1. Why was my brother taken? Answer: It is part of an eternal p<u>lan</u>

**Matthew 10:16** "Behold, I send you out as sheep in the midst of wolves; therefore be shrewd as serpents, and innocent as doves.

<sup>17</sup> "But beware of men; for they will deliver you up to *the* courts, and scourge you in their synagogues; <sup>18</sup> and you shall even be brought before governors and kings for My sake, as a testimony to them and to the Gentiles.

<sup>19</sup> "But when they deliver you up, do not become anxious about how or what you will speak; for it shall be given you in that hour what you are to speak.

<sup>20</sup> "For it is not you who speak, but *it is* the Spirit of your Father who speaks in you.

<sup>21</sup> "And brother will deliver up brother to death, and a father *his* child; and children will rise up against parents, and cause them to be put to death.

<sup>22</sup> "And you will be hated by all on account of My name...

**Matthew 24:9** "Then they will deliver you to tribulation, and will kill you, and you will be hated by all nations on account of My name.

<sup>10</sup> "And at that time many will fall away and will deliver up one another and hate one another.

**Matthew 28:18** And Jesus came up and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.

<sup>19</sup> "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit,

<sup>20</sup> teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

Acts 14:21 And after they had preached the gospel to that city and had made many disciples, they returned to Lystra and to Iconium and to Antioch,

<sup>22</sup> strengthening the souls of the disciples, encouraging them to continue in the faith, and *saying*, "Through many tribulations we must enter the kingdom of God."

### Q2. What can we do? Answer:

#### 1. Never forget that he is my brother and he and his family are hurting

**1** Corinthians 12:12 For even as the body is one and *yet* has many members, and all the members of the body, though they are many, are one body, so also is Christ.

<sup>13</sup> For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to drink of one Spirit.

**1** Corinthians **12:26** And if one member suffers, all the members suffer with it; if *one* member is honored, all the members rejoice with it.

<sup>27</sup> Now you are Christ's body, and individually members of it.

Hebrews 13:1 Let love of the brethren continue.

<sup>2</sup> Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers, for by this some have entertained angels without knowing it.

<sup>3</sup> Remember the prisoners, as though in prison with them, and those who are ill-treated, since you yourselves also are in the body.

#### 2. P<u>ray</u>

**Romans 15:29** And I know that when I come to you, I will come in the fulness of the blessing of Christ. <sup>30</sup> Now I urge you, brethren, by our Lord Jesus Christ and by the love of the Spirit, to strive together with me in your prayers to God for me,

<sup>31</sup> that I may be delivered from those who are disobedient in Judea, and *that* my service for Jerusalem may prove acceptable to the saints;

<sup>32</sup> so that I may come to you in joy by the will of God and find *refreshing* rest in your company.

**Ephesians 6:19** and *pray* on my behalf, that utterance may be given to me in the opening of my mouth, to make known with boldness the mystery of the gospel,

<sup>20</sup> for which I am an ambassador in chains; that in *proclaiming* it I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak.
<sup>21</sup> But that you also may know about my circumstances, how I am doing, Tychicus, the beloved brother and faithful minister in the Lord, will make everything known to you.

**Colossians 4:2** Devote yourselves to prayer, keeping alert in it with *an attitude of* thanksgiving; <sup>3</sup> praying at the same time for us as well, that God may open up to us a door for the word, so that we may speak forth the mystery of Christ, for which I have also been imprisoned;

<sup>4</sup> in order that I may make it clear in the way I ought to speak.

<sup>5</sup> Conduct yourselves with wisdom toward outsiders, making the most of the opportunity.

<sup>6</sup> Let your speech always be with grace, seasoned, *as it were*, with salt, so that you may know how you should respond to each person.

<sup>7</sup> As to all my affairs, Tychicus, *our* beloved brother and faithful servant and fellow bond-servant in the Lord, will bring you information.

<sup>8</sup> For I have sent him to you for this very purpose, that you may know *about* our circumstances and that he may encourage your hearts;

#### 3. Try to stay informed of his condition

**2 Corinthians 1:8** For we do not want you to be unaware, brethren, of our affliction which came *to us* in Asia, that we were burdened excessively, beyond our strength, so that we despaired even of life; <sup>9</sup> indeed, we had the sentence of death within ourselves in order that we should not trust in ourselves, but in God who raises the dead;

#### 4. Try to communicate with him

**Hebrews 10:32** But remember the former days, when, after being enlightened, you endured a great conflict of sufferings,

<sup>33</sup> partly, by being made a public spectacle through reproaches and tribulations, and partly by becoming sharers with those who were so treated.

<sup>34</sup> For you showed sympathy to the prisoners, and accepted joyfully the seizure of your property, knowing that you have for yourselves a better possession and an abiding one.

#### 5. Try to a<u>dvocate</u> for him

Acts 16:35 Now when day came, the chief magistrates sent their policemen, saying, "Release those men."

<sup>36</sup> And the jailer reported these words to Paul, *saying*, "The chief magistrates have sent to release you. Now therefore, come out and go in peace."

<sup>37</sup> But Paul said to them, "They have beaten us in public without trial, men who are Romans, and have thrown us into prison; and now are they sending us away secretly? No indeed! But let them come themselves and bring us out."

<sup>38</sup> And the policemen reported these words to the chief magistrates. And they were afraid when they heard that they were Romans,

<sup>39</sup> and they came and appealed to them, and when they had brought them out, they kept begging them to leave the city.

#### 6. Support his family

**2 Corinthians 8:1** Now, brethren, we *wish to* make known to you the grace of God which has been given in the churches of Macedonia,

<sup>2</sup> that in a great ordeal of affliction their abundance of joy and their deep poverty overflowed in the wealth of their liberality.

<sup>3</sup> For I testify that according to their ability, and beyond their ability *they gave* of their own accord,

<sup>4</sup> begging us with much entreaty for the favor of participation in the support of the saints,

<sup>5</sup> and *this*, not as we had expected, but they first gave themselves to the Lord and to us by the will of God.

#### 7. Follow his example

**Philippians 1:12** Now I want you to know, brethren, that my circumstances have turned out for the greater progress of the gospel,

<sup>13</sup> so that my imprisonment in *the cause of* Christ has become well known throughout the whole praetorian guard and to everyone else,

<sup>14</sup> and that most of the brethren, trusting in the Lord because of my imprisonment, have far more courage to speak the word of God without fear.

#### 8. J<u>oin</u> the team who is trying to help him
