# God's Call from 1 Corinthians 16 Regarding HURRICANE IRMA

10/1/17

#### 1. A Call to Help

**1 Corinthians 16:1** Now concerning the collection for the saints, as I directed the churches of Galatia, so do you also.

- <sup>2</sup> On the first day of every week let each one of you put aside and save, as he may prosper, that no collections be made when I come.
- <sup>3</sup> And when I arrive, whomever you may approve, I shall send them with letters to carry your gift to Jerusalem;
- <sup>4</sup> and if it is fitting for me to go also, they will go with me.

#### 2. A Call to Bring Healing

- <sup>5</sup> But I shall come to you after I go through Macedonia, for I am going through Macedonia;
- <sup>6</sup> and perhaps I shall stay with you, or even spend the winter, that you may send me on my way wherever I may go.
- <sup>7</sup> For I do not wish to see you now *just* in passing; for I hope to remain with you for some time, if the Lord permits.

### 3. A Call to Bring Hope

- <sup>8</sup> But I shall remain in Ephesus until Pentecost;
- <sup>9</sup> for a wide door for effective *service* has opened to me, and there are many adversaries.

## 4. A Call to Respect

- <sup>10</sup> Now if Timothy comes, see that he is with you without cause to be afraid; for he is doing the Lord's work, as I also am.
- <sup>11</sup> Let no one therefore despise him. But send him on his way in peace, so that he may come to me; for I expect him with the brethren.
- <sup>12</sup> But concerning Apollos our brother, I encouraged him greatly to come to you with the brethren; and it was not at all *his* desire to come now, but he will come when he has opportunity.

#### 5. A Call to Be Strong

<sup>13</sup> Be on the alert, stand firm in the faith, act like men, be strong.

#### 6. A Call to Love

<sup>14</sup> Let all that you do be done in love.

#### 7. A Call to S

- <sup>15</sup> Now I urge you, brethren (you know the household of Stephanas, that they were the first fruits of Achaia, and that they have devoted themselves for ministry to the saints),
- <sup>16</sup> that you also be in subjection to such men and to everyone who helps in the work and labors.

## 8. A Call to Recognize R\_\_\_\_\_

<sup>17</sup> And I rejoice over the coming of Stephanas and Fortunatus and Achaicus; because they have supplied what was lacking on your part.

<sup>18</sup> For they have refreshed my spirit and yours. Therefore acknowledge such men.

## 9. A Call to G\_\_\_\_\_ One Another

<sup>19</sup> The churches of Asia greet you. Aquila and Prisca greet you heartily in the Lord, with the church that is in their house.

<sup>20</sup> All the brethren greet you. Greet one another with a holy kiss.

#### 10. A Call to G

- <sup>21</sup> The greeting is in my own hand-- Paul.
- <sup>22</sup> If anyone does not love the Lord, let him be accursed. Maranatha.
- <sup>23</sup> The grace of the Lord Jesus be with you.
- <sup>24</sup> My love be with you all in Christ Jesus. Amen.

#### Some Scriptures which apply to call #8

**Proverbs 10:11** The mouth of the righteous is a fountain of life

Proverbs 10:21 The lips of the righteous feed many

**Proverbs 12:18** There is one who speaks rashly like the thrusts of a sword, But the tongue of the wise brings healing.

Proverbs 18:21 Death and life are in the power of the tongue, And those who love it will eat its fruit

**Proverbs 25:11** *Like* apples of gold in settings of silver Is a word spoken in right circumstances.

<sup>12</sup> Like an earring of gold and an ornament of fine gold Is a wise reprover to a listening ear.

**John 15:11** "These things I have spoken to you, that My joy may be in you, and *that* your joy may be made full.

**Acts 5:40** And they took his advice; and after calling the apostles in, they flogged them and ordered them to speak no more in the name of Jesus, and *then* released them.

<sup>41</sup> So they went on their way from the presence of the Council, rejoicing that they had been considered worthy to suffer shame for *His* name.

<sup>42</sup> And every day, in the temple and from house to house, they kept right on teaching and preaching Jesus *as* the Christ.

**2 Corinthians 6:4** but in everything commending ourselves as servants of God, in much endurance, in afflictions, in hardships, in distresses,

<sup>5</sup> in beatings, in imprisonments, in tumults, in labors, in sleeplessness, in hunger,...

<sup>10</sup> as sorrowful yet always rejoicing, as poor yet making many rich, as having nothing yet possessing all things.

**Ephesians 4:29** Let no unwholesome word proceed from your mouth, but only such *a word* as is good for edification according to the need *of the moment*, that it may give grace to those who hear.

#### **Ephesians 5:18** ... be filled with the Spirit,

- <sup>19</sup> speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody with your heart to the Lord;
- <sup>20</sup> always giving thanks for all things in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to God, even the Father;

**Philippians 2:17** But even if I am being poured out as a drink offering upon the sacrifice and service of your faith, I rejoice and share my joy with you all.

<sup>18</sup> And you too, *I urge you*, rejoice in the same way and share your joy with me.

**Colossians 3:16** Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you, with all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another with psalms *and* hymns *and* spiritual songs, singing with thankfulness in your hearts to God.

<sup>17</sup> And whatever you do in word or deed, *do* all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through Him to God the Father.

**Colossians 4:6** Let your speech always be with grace, seasoned, *as it were*, with salt, so that you may know how you should respond to each person.

- **1 Thessalonians 3:8** for now we *really* live, if you stand firm in the Lord.
- <sup>9</sup> For what thanks can we render to God for you in return for all the joy with which we rejoice before our God on your account,
- <sup>10</sup> as we night and day keep praying most earnestly that we may see your face, and may complete what is lacking in your faith?
- 1 Thessalonians 5:16 Rejoice always;
- <sup>17</sup> pray without ceasing;
- <sup>18</sup> in everything give thanks; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

Hebrews 10:24 and let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds,

<sup>25</sup> not forsaking our own assembling together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging *one another*; and all the more, as you see the day drawing near.
