

Some Objections and The Truth

**Romans 2:28** For he is not a Jew who is one outwardly; neither is circumcision that which is outward in the flesh.

<sup>29</sup> But he is a Jew who is one inwardly; and circumcision is that which is of the heart, by the Spirit, not by the letter; and his praise is not from men, but from God.

## Objection #1 Religious Upbringing

**3:1** Then what advantage has the Jew? Or what is the benefit of circumcision?

<sup>2</sup> Great in every respect. First of all, that they were entrusted with the oracles of God.

#### Objection #2 Popular Opinion

<sup>3</sup> What then? If some did not believe, their unbelief will not nullify the faithfulness of God, will it?

<sup>4</sup> May it never be! Rather, let God be found true, though every man *be found* a liar, as it is written, "That Thou mightest be justified in Thy words, And mightest prevail when Thou art judged."

# Objection #3 Our Sin Makes God Look Good

<sup>5</sup> But if our unrighteousness demonstrates the righteousness of God, what shall we say? The God who inflicts wrath is not unrighteous, is He? (I am speaking in human terms.)

<sup>6</sup> May it never be! For otherwise how will God judge the world?

<sup>7</sup> But if through my lie the truth of God abounded to His glory, why am I also still being judged as a sinner?

<sup>8</sup> And why not *say* (as we are slanderously reported and as some affirm that we say), "Let us do evil that good may come "? Their condemnation is just.

## Truth **#1 The Bad News**

<sup>9</sup> What then? Are we better than they? Not at all; for we have already charged that both Jews and Greeks are all under sin;

<sup>10</sup> as it is written, "There is none righteous, not even one;

<sup>11</sup> There is none who understands, There is none who seeks for God;

<sup>12</sup> All have turned aside, together they have become useless; There is none who does good, There is not even one."

<sup>13</sup> "Their throat is an open grave, With their tongues they keep deceiving," "The poison of asps is under their lips";

<sup>14</sup> "Whose mouth is full of cursing and bitterness";

<sup>15</sup> "Their feet are swift to shed blood,

<sup>16</sup> Destruction and misery are in their paths,

<sup>17</sup> And the path of peace have they not known."

<sup>18</sup> "There is no fear of God before their eyes."

<sup>19</sup> Now we know that whatever the Law says, it speaks to those who are under the Law, that every mouth may be closed, and all the world may become accountable to God;

<sup>20</sup> because by the works of the Law no flesh will be justified in His sight; for through the Law *comes* the knowledge of sin.

### Truth #2 The Good News

<sup>21</sup> But now apart from the Law *the* righteousness of God has been manifested, being witnessed by the Law and the Prophets,

<sup>22</sup> even *the* righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all those who believe; for there is no distinction;

<sup>23</sup> for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

<sup>24</sup> being justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus;

<sup>25</sup> whom God displayed publicly as a propitiation in His blood through faith. *This was* to demonstrate His righteousness, because in the forbearance of God He passed over the sins previously committed;

<sup>26</sup> for the demonstration, *I say*, of His righteousness at the present time, that He might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.

#### Truth #3 The Choice (see verses 22, 25, 26, 27, 28, 30 and 31)

<sup>27</sup> Where then is boasting? It is excluded. By what kind of law? Of works? No, but by a law of faith.

<sup>28</sup> For we maintain that a man is justified by faith apart from works of the Law.

<sup>29</sup> Or is God *the God* of Jews only? Is He not *the God* of Gentiles also? Yes, of Gentiles also,

<sup>30</sup> since indeed God who will justify the circumcised by faith and the uncircumcised through faith is one.

<sup>31</sup> Do we then nullify the Law through faith? May it never be! On the contrary, we establish the Law.

**2 Timothy 3:14** ...continue in the things you have learned and become convinced of, knowing from whom you have learned *them*;

<sup>15</sup> and that from childhood you have known the sacred writings which are able to give you the wisdom that leads to salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.

<sup>16</sup> All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness;

<sup>17</sup> that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work.

**Jeremiah 31:31** "Behold, days are coming," declares the LORD, "when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah,

<sup>32</sup> not like the covenant which I made with their fathers in the day I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, although I was a husband to them," declares the LORD.

<sup>33</sup> "But this is the covenant which I will make with the house of Israel after those days," declares the LORD, "I will put My law within them, and on their heart I will write it; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people.

<sup>34</sup> "And they shall not teach again, each man his neighbor and each man his brother, saying, 'Know the LORD,' for they shall all know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them," declares the LORD, "for I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more."
