The sanctity (set apartness) of God and people

Genesis 1:26 Then God said, "Let Us make man in <u>Our image</u>, according to <u>Our likeness</u>; and <u>let them rule</u> ...

Psalm 8:1 O Lord, our Lord, <u>How majestic is Thy name</u> in all the earth, Who hast displayed Thy splendor above the heavens!...

- ... ³ When I consider Thy heavens, the work of Thy fingers, The moon and the stars, which Thou hast ordained:
- ⁴ What is man, that Thou dost take thought of him? And the son of man, that Thou dost care for him?
- ⁵ Yet Thou hast made him a little lower than God, And dost crown him with glory and majesty!
- ⁶ Thou dost make him to rule over the works of Thy hands; Thou hast put all things under his feet ...
- ... 9 O LORD, our Lord, How majestic is Thy name in all the earth!

The sanctity of the saints (the set apart people)

1 Corinthians 1:1 Paul, called *as* an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, and Sosthenes our brother, ² to the church of God which is at Corinth, to those who <u>have been **sanctified**</u> in Christ Jesus, <u>saints</u> by <u>calling</u>, with all who in every place call upon the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, their *Lord* and ours

What are the saints (set apart people) set apart to do?

We are set apart to worship

- **1 Peter 1:1** Peter, an apostle of Jesus Christ, to those who reside as aliens, scattered throughout Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia, and Bithynia, who are chosen
- ² according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, by the sanctifying work of the Spirit...

1 Peter 2:9 ...you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, <u>a **holy** nation</u>, a people for *God's* own possession, <u>that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him</u> who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light...

We are set apart to witness through persecution (we studied this last Sunday)

2 Timothy 1:8 ...Therefore do not be ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, or of me His prisoner; but join with me in suffering for the gospel according to the power of God,

⁹ who has saved us, and called us with <u>a **holy** calling</u>, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was granted us in Christ Jesus from all eternity... (see also Matthew 10:18).

We are set apart to serve

Philippians 1:1 Paul and Timothy, <u>bond-servants</u> of Christ Jesus, to all the **saints** in Christ Jesus who are in Philippi, including the overseers and deacons:

Philippians 2:5 Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus,

- ⁶ who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped,
- ⁷ but emptied Himself, taking the form of a <u>bond-servant</u>, *and* being made in the likeness of men.
- ⁸ And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.
- ⁹ Therefore also God highly exalted Him, and bestowed on Him the name which is above every name,
- ¹⁰ that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those who are in heaven, and on earth, and under the earth,
- ¹¹ and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
- ¹² So then, my beloved, just as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your salvation with fear and trembling;
- ¹³ for it is God who is at work in you, both to will and to work for *Hi*s good pleasure.

Deacons are a gift to us as example servants

1 Timothy 3:8 Deacons likewise *must be* men of dignity,

not double-tongued,

or addicted to much wine

or fond of sordid gain,

- ¹⁰ And let these also first be tested; then let them serve as deacons if they are beyond reproach.
- ¹¹ Women *must* likewise *be* dignified,

not malicious gossips,

but temperate,

faithful in all things.

and good managers of their children and their own households.

- ¹³ For those who have served well as deacons obtain for themselves a high standing and great confidence in the faith that is in Christ Jesus.
- ¹⁴ I am writing these things to you, hoping to come to you before long;
- ¹⁵ but in case I am delayed, *I write* so that you may know how one ought to conduct himself in the household of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and support of the truth.
- ¹⁶ And by common confession great is the mystery of godliness: He who was revealed in the flesh, Was vindicated in the Spirit, Beheld by angels, Proclaimed among the nations, Believed on in the world, Taken up in glory.

⁹ but holding to the mystery of the faith with a clear conscience.

¹² Let deacons be husbands of *only* one wife,
