i. We represent the kingdom of heaven

Philippians 3:20... our citizenship is in heaven, from which also we eagerly wait for a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ;

1 Peter 2:9 ... you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation,

a people for *God's* own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;

¹⁰ for you once were not a people, but now you are the people of God...

2 Corinthians 5:20 ... we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were entreating through us; we beg you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God.

ii. As heaven's representatives we seek the wellbeing of the kingdom of heaven and of America

Matthew 6:33 "...seek first His kingdom and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added to you.

Psalm 33:12 Blessed is the nation whose God is the LORD...

Proverbs 11:11 By the blessing of the upright a city is exalted...

Proverbs 14:34 Righteousness exalts a nation, But sin is a disgrace to any people.

Jeremiah 29:1 Now these are the words of the letter which Jeremiah the prophet sent from Jerusalem to the rest of the elders of the exile...

... ⁷ 'seek the welfare of the city where I have sent you into exile, and pray to the LORD on its behalf; for in its welfare you will have welfare.'

I. Vote

- A. Vote applying these considerations (regarding all candidates):
- 1. There are no perfect candidates; vote anyway

 As an illustration consider that God voted for David (1 Samuel 16)
- 2. We may need to move past the person to their platform
- 3. We may need to move past who most promotes our values to who least opposes our values
- 4. Seek godly council and pray for wisdom

B. Vote applying God's ten priorities for a society in their prioritized order (regarding all candidates)

1. The Bible implies a prioritized order of God's Ten Priorities

- a. The prophets' warnings to Israel and to the nations as well as New Testament warnings show a prioritized order
- b. Matthew 22:35 And one of them, a lawyer, asked Him a question, testing Him,
- ³⁶ "Teacher, which is the great commandment in the Law?"
- ³⁷ And He said to him, "'You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind.'
- ³⁸ "This is the great and foremost commandment.
- ³⁹ "The <u>second</u> is like it, 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.'
- ⁴⁰ "On these two commandments depend the whole Law and the Prophets."
- c. **Matthew 23:23** "Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you tithe mint and dill and cummin, and have neglected the weightier provisions of the law: justice and mercy and faithfulness; ...
- d. **1 Corinthians 5:11 ...** I wrote to you not to associate with any so-called brother if he should be an <u>immoral</u> person, or <u>covetous</u>, or an <u>idolater</u>, or a <u>reviler</u>, or a <u>drunkard</u>, or a <u>swindler</u> not even to eat with such a one.
- ¹² For what have I to do with judging outsiders? Do you not judge those who are within *the church*?
- ¹³ But those who are outside, God judges. Remove the wicked man from among yourselves.

2. God's ten priorities for a society in their prioritized order:

Exodus 20:1 Then God spoke all these words, saying,

² "I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery.

I. ³	³ "You	shall	have	no	other	gods	before	Me.
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___A trust in God, not secularism, naturalism or syncretism

- II. ⁴ "You shall not make for yourself an idol, or any likeness of what is in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the water under the earth.
- ⁵ "You shall not worship them or serve them; for I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children, on the third and the fourth generations of those who hate Me,
- ⁶ but showing lovingkindness to thousands, to those who love Me and keep My commandments.
 - A focus on God not creation or any part of it

III. ⁷ "You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain, for the LORD will not leave him unpunished who takes His name in vain.

IV. 8 "Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy.

- ⁹ "Six days you shall labor and do all your work,
- ¹⁰ but the seventh day is a sabbath of the LORD your God; *in it* you shall not do any work, you or your son or your daughter, your male or your female servant or your cattle or your sojourner who stays with you.
- ¹¹ "For in six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea and all that is in them, and rested on the seventh day; therefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day and made it holy.

 V. ¹² "Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be prolonged in the land which the LORD your God gives you. —Honor and protection of the biblical family structure
