# The glory of God

**Luke 2:7** And she gave birth to her first-born son; and she wrapped Him in cloths, and laid Him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn.

- <sup>8</sup> And in the same region there were *some* shepherds staying out in the fields, and keeping watch over their flock by night.
- <sup>9</sup> And an angel of the Lord suddenly stood before them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them; and they were terribly frightened.
- <sup>10</sup> And the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid; for behold, I bring you good news of a great joy which shall be for all the people;
- <sup>11</sup> for today in the city of David there has been born for you a Savior, who is Christ the Lord.
- <sup>12</sup> "And this will be a sign for you: you will find a baby wrapped in cloths, and lying in a manger."
- <sup>13</sup> And suddenly there appeared with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying,
- <sup>14</sup> "Glory to God in the highest, And on earth peace among men with whom He is pleased."

**John 1:14** And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth.

**Hebrews 1:3** And He is the radiance of His glory and the exact representation of His nature, and upholds all things by the word of His power...

**Revelation 21:23** And the city has no need of the sun or of the moon to shine upon it, for the glory of God has illumined it, and its lamp *is* the Lamb.

Matthew 13:43 "Then the righteous will shine forth as the sun in the kingdom of their Father

The glory of God is His perfect, radiating awesomeness.

How to glorify God: adore and honor God for His awesomeness

# The revelation of Christmas

God is perfectly awesome in His...

# 1. faithfulness

**Matthew 1:21**"And she will bear a Son; and you shall call His name Jesus, for it is He who will save His people from their sins."

- <sup>22</sup> Now all this took place that what was spoken by the Lord through the prophet might be fulfilled, saying,
- <sup>23</sup> "Behold, the virgin shall be with child, and shall bear a Son, and they shall call His name Immanuel," which translated means, "God with us."

#### 2. power (omnipotence)

**Luke 1:35** And the angel answered and said to her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; and for that reason the holy offspring shall be called the Son of God.

- <sup>36</sup> "And behold, even your relative Elizabeth has also conceived a son in her old age; and she who was called barren is now in her sixth month.
- <sup>37</sup> "For nothing will be impossible with God."

## 3. justice (righteousness)

Romans 3:23 ... all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

<sup>24</sup> being justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus;

whom God displayed publicly as a propitiation in His blood through faith. *This was* to demonstrate His righteousness, because in the forbearance of God He passed over the sins previously committed;

<sup>26</sup> for the demonstration, *I say*, of His righteousness at the present time, that He might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.

#### 4. wrath

**1 John 4:9** By this the love of God was manifested in us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world so that we might live through Him.

<sup>10</sup> In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son *to be* the propitiation for our sins.

# 5. grace (love, mercy, forgiveness)

**Romans 5:8** ...God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

<sup>9</sup> Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from the wrath *of God* through Him.

<sup>10</sup> For if while we were enemies, we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.

#### 6. fatherliness

**Galatians 4:4** ...when the fulness of the time came, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the Law,

- <sup>5</sup> in order that He might redeem those who were under the Law, that we might receive the adoption as sons.
- <sup>6</sup> And because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!"

<sup>7</sup> Therefore you are no longer a slave, but a son; and if a son, then an heir through God.

# 7. patience

**Hebrews 2:17** Therefore, He had to be made like His brethren in all things, that He might become a merciful and faithful high priest in things pertaining to God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people.

<sup>18</sup> For since He Himself was tempted in that which He has suffered, He is able to come to the aid of those who are tempted.

#### 8. holiness

**Hebrews 4:14** Since then we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession.

<sup>15</sup> For we do not have a high priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but One who has been tempted in all things as *we are, yet* without sin.

<sup>16</sup> Let us therefore draw near with confidence to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and may find grace to help in time of need.

# 9. wisdom (omniscience)

**Ephesians 3:8** To me, the very least of all saints, this grace was given, to preach to the Gentiles the unfathomable riches of Christ,

<sup>9</sup> and to bring to light what is the administration of the mystery which for ages has been hidden in God, who created all things;

<sup>10</sup> in order that the manifold wisdom of God might now be made known through the church to the rulers and the authorities in the heavenly *places*.

11 This was in accordance with the eternal purpose which He carried out in Christ Jesus our Lord,

<sup>12</sup> in whom we have boldness and confident access through faith in Him.

## 10. humility

**Mark 10:45** "For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

# 11. joy

**John 15:11** "These things I have spoken to you, that My joy may be in you, and *that* your joy may be made full.

# 12. peace

**John 14:27** "Peace I leave with you; My peace I give to you; not as the world gives, do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, nor let it be fearful.

# The gift of glory

**John 17:1** These things Jesus spoke; and lifting up His eyes to heaven, He said, "Father, the hour has come; glorify Thy Son, that the Son may glorify Thee,

- <sup>2</sup> even as Thou gavest Him authority over all mankind, that to all whom Thou hast given Him, He may give eternal life.
- <sup>3</sup> "And this is eternal life, that they may know Thee, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom Thou hast sent.
- <sup>4</sup> "I glorified Thee on the earth, having accomplished the work which Thou hast given Me to do.
- <sup>5</sup> "And now, glorify Thou Me together with Thyself, Father, with the glory which I had with Thee before the world was.
- ... <sup>10</sup> and all things that are Mine are Thine, and Thine are Mine; and I have been glorified in them.
- ... <sup>20</sup> "I do not ask in behalf of these alone, but for those also who believe in Me through their word;
- <sup>21</sup> that they may all be one; even as Thou, Father, *art* in Me, and I in Thee, that they also may be in Us; that the world may believe that Thou didst send Me.
- <sup>22</sup> "And the glory which Thou hast given Me I have given to them; that they may be one, just as We are one; <sup>23</sup> I in them, and Thou in Me, that they may be perfected in unity, that the world may know that Thou didst
- send Me, and didst love them, even as Thou didst love Me.
