

**Ephesians 6:1**

Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right.

**Colossians 3:20** Children, be obedient to your parents in all things, for this is well-pleasing to the Lord.

**Luke 2:51** And He (Jesus) went down with them, and came to Nazareth; and He continued in subjection to them...

**Genesis 2:24** For this cause a man shall leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave to his wife; and they shall become one flesh.

**Acts 5:29** Peter and the apostles answered and said, "We must obey God rather than men.

**Ephesians 6:2-3**

Honor your father and mother

(which is the first commandment with a promise),

<sup>3</sup>that it may be well with you,

and that you may live long on the earth.

**Proverbs 13:1** A wise son *accepts his* father's discipline, But a scoffer does not listen to rebuke.

**Proverbs 23:22** Listen to your father who begot you, And do not despise your mother when she is old.

<sup>23</sup> Buy truth, and do not sell *it*, Get wisdom and instruction and understanding.

<sup>24</sup> The father of the righteous will greatly rejoice, And he who begets a wise son will be glad in him.

<sup>25</sup> Let your father and your mother be glad, And let her rejoice who gave birth to you.

<sup>26</sup> Give me your heart, my son, And let your eyes delight in my ways.

**Proverbs 6:20** My son, observe the commandment of your father, And do not forsake the teaching of your mother;

<sup>21</sup> Bind them continually on your heart; Tie them around your neck.

<sup>22</sup> When you walk about, they will guide you; When you sleep, they will watch over you; And when you awake, they will talk to you.

<sup>23</sup> For the commandment is a lamp, and the teaching is light; And reproofs for discipline are the way of life,

**1 Timothy 5:1** Do not sharply rebuke an older man, but *rather* appeal to *him* as a father, *to* the younger men as brothers,

<sup>2</sup> the older women as mothers, *and* the younger women as sisters, in all purity.

<sup>3</sup> Honor widows who are widows indeed;

<sup>4</sup> but if any widow has children or grandchildren, let them first learn to practice piety in regard to their own family, and to make some return to their parents; for this is acceptable in the sight of God.

<sup>5</sup> Now she who is a widow indeed, and who has been left alone has fixed her hope on God, and continues in entreaties and prayers night and day.

<sup>6</sup> But she who gives herself to wanton pleasure is dead even while she lives.

<sup>7</sup> Prescribe these things as well, so that they may be above reproach.

<sup>8</sup> But if anyone does not provide for his own, and especially for those of his household, he has denied the faith, and is worse than an unbeliever.

**Ephesians 6:4a**

And, fathers, do not provoke your children to anger;

**Colossians 3:21** Fathers, do not exasperate your children, that they may not lose heart.

**Ephesians 4:26** Be angry, and *yet* do not sin; do not let the sun go down on your anger,

<sup>27</sup> and do not give the devil an opportunity.

<sup>28</sup> Let him who steals steal no longer; but rather let him labor, performing with his own hands what is good, in order that he may have *something* to share with him who has need.

<sup>29</sup> Let no unwholesome word proceed from your mouth, but only such a *word* as is good for edification according to the need *of the moment*, that it may give grace to those who hear.

<sup>30</sup> And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.

<sup>31</sup> Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all malice.

<sup>32</sup> And be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you.

**5:1** Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children;

<sup>2</sup> and walk in love, just as Christ also loved you, and gave Himself up for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God as a fragrant aroma.

**Proverbs 22:24** Do not associate with a man *given* to anger; Or go with a hot-tempered man,

<sup>25</sup> Lest you learn his ways, And find a snare for yourself.

**Ephesians 6:4b**

but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.

**Proverbs 19:18** Discipline your son while there is hope, And do not desire his death.

**Proverbs 23:13** Do not hold back discipline from the child,

Although you beat him with the rod, he will not die.

<sup>14</sup> You shall beat him with the rod, And deliver his soul from Sheol.

**Proverbs 29:17** Correct your son, and he will give you comfort; He will also delight your soul.

**Proverbs 13:24** He who spares his rod hates his son,  
But he who loves him disciplines him diligently.

**Proverbs 22:15** Foolishness is bound up in the heart of a child;  
The rod of discipline will remove it far from him.

**Proverbs 29:15** The rod and reproof give wisdom,  
But a child who gets his own way brings shame to his mother

**Proverbs 17:10** A rebuke goes deeper into one who has understanding  
Than a hundred blows into a fool.

**Proverbs 22:6** Train up a child in the way he should go,  
Even when he is old he will not depart from it.

**Proverbs 1:8** Hear, my son, your father's instruction,  
And do not forsake your mother's teaching;

**Deuteronomy 6:4** "Hear, O Israel! The LORD is our God, the LORD is one!

<sup>5</sup> "And you shall love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might.

<sup>6</sup> "And these words, which I am commanding you today, shall be on your heart;

<sup>7</sup> and you shall teach them diligently to your sons and shall talk of them when you sit in your house and when you walk by the way and when you lie down and when you rise up.

**2 Timothy 3:12** ...all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will be persecuted.

<sup>13</sup> But evil men and impostors will proceed *from bad* to worse, deceiving and being deceived.

<sup>14</sup> You, however, continue in the things you have learned and become convinced of, knowing from whom you have learned *them*;

<sup>15</sup> and that from childhood you have known the sacred writings which are able to give you the wisdom that leads to salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.

<sup>16</sup> All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness;

<sup>17</sup> that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work.
