## How to raise children of peace

- 1. Set an example of peace. Model and teach that anger produces ministry (not suppression or aggression). Model righteous anger.
- 2. provide a joyful home
- 3. prayerfully study your child (the root of anger: pain, frustration or fear)
- 4. listen (really listen), empathize, affirm and pray
- 5. honor and love their mother (inability to protect Mom produces anger)
- 6. honor and love the child
- 7. be there
- 8. keep "promises"
- 9. set age-appropriate expectations
- 10. inspire achievement while avoiding perfectionism
- 11. avoid being critical
- 12. avoid being too restrictive as well as too permissive
- 13. encourage without flattery
- 14. avoid sarcasm
- 15. be careful with humor
- 16. teach conviction of sin without crushing the spirit
- 17. be generous without spoiling
- 18. teach how to win and how to lose
- 19 reward character
- 20. avoid comparisons
- 21. avoid favoritism
- 22. discipline
  - a. with clear boundaries and consequences

- b. communicating love (before, during and after)
- c. calmly (never in anger; never yelling)
- d. privately (avoid public embarrassment)
- e. consistently
- f. swiftly
- 23. bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord:

Proverbs 19:18 Discipline your son while there is hope, And do not desire his death.

Proverbs 23:13 Do not hold back discipline from the child,

Although you beat him with the rod, he will not die.

Proverbs 22:6 Train up a child in the way he should go,

**Proverbs 1:8** Hear, my son, your father's instruction,

And do not forsake your mother's teaching;

Deuteronomy 6:4 "Hear, O Israel! The LORD is our God, the LORD is one!

- <sup>5</sup> "And you shall love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might.
- <sup>6</sup> "And these words, which I am commanding you today, shall be on your heart;
- <sup>7</sup> and you shall teach them diligently to your sons and shall talk of them when you sit in your house and when you walk by the way and when you lie down and when you rise up.

## Ephesians 6:5-9

<sup>5</sup>Slaves, be obedient to those who are your masters according to the flesh,

with fear and trembling,

in the sincerity of your heart,

as to Christ;

  - B but as slaves of Christ,
    - C doing the will of God
      - D from the heart.
      - <sup>™</sup>7With good will
    - C' render(ing) service,
  - B' as to the Lord,

8knowing that whatever good thing each one does,

this he will receive back from the Lord,

whether slave or free.

and give(ing) up threatening,
