## **Ephesians 6:18-24**

<sup>18</sup>With all prayer and petition  
pray at all times  
in the Spirit,

and with this in view,  
be on the alert  
with all perseverance and petition for all the saints

<sup>19</sup>and  
*pray* on my behalf,  
that utterance may be given to me in the opening of my mouth,  
to make known with boldness the mystery of the gospel,  
<sup>20</sup> for which I am an ambassador in chains;  
that in *proclaiming* it I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak.

<sup>21</sup>But that you also may know about my circumstances, how I am doing, Tychicus,  
the beloved brother and faithful minister in the Lord,  
will make everything known to you.

<sup>22</sup>And I have sent him to you for this very purpose,  
so that you may know about us,  
and that he may comfort your hearts.

<sup>23</sup>Peace be to the brethren, and love with faith,  
from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

<sup>24</sup>Grace be with all those who love our Lord Jesus Christ with a *love* incorruptible.

**Ephesians 1:13** In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation--  
having also believed, you were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise,

<sup>14</sup> who is given as a pledge of our inheritance, with a view to the redemption of *God's own* possession,  
to the praise of His glory.

<sup>15</sup> For this reason I too, having heard of the faith in the Lord Jesus which *exists* among you, and your  
love for all the saints,

<sup>16</sup> do not cease giving thanks for you, while making mention *of you* in my prayers;

<sup>17</sup> that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you a spirit of wisdom and of  
revelation in the knowledge of Him.

<sup>18</sup> *I pray that* the eyes of your heart may be enlightened, so that you may know what is the hope of His  
calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints,

<sup>19</sup> and what is the surpassing greatness of His power toward us who believe. *These are* in accordance  
with the working of the strength of His might

<sup>20</sup> which He brought about in Christ, when He raised Him from the dead, and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly *places*,

<sup>21</sup> far above all rule and authority and power and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age, but also in the one to come.

<sup>22</sup> And He put all things in subjection under His feet, and gave Him as head over all things to the church,

<sup>23</sup> which is His body, the fulness of Him who fills all in all.

**Ephesians 2:4** ... God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us,

<sup>5</sup> even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved),

<sup>6</sup> and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly *places*, in Christ Jesus

**Ephesians 2:18** ... through Him we both have our access in one Spirit to the Father.

<sup>19</sup> So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints, and are of God's household,

<sup>20</sup> having been built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus Himself being the corner *stone*,

<sup>21</sup> in whom the whole building, being fitted together is growing into a holy temple in the Lord;

<sup>22</sup> in whom you also are being built together into a dwelling of God in the Spirit.

**Ephesians 3:13** ... I ask you not to lose heart at my tribulations on your behalf, for they are your glory.

<sup>14</sup> For this reason, I bow my knees before the Father,

<sup>15</sup> from whom every family in heaven and on earth derives its name,

<sup>16</sup> that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with power through His Spirit in the inner man;

<sup>17</sup> so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; *and* that you, being rooted and grounded in love,

<sup>18</sup> may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth,

<sup>19</sup> and to know the love of Christ which surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled up to all the fulness of God.

<sup>20</sup> Now to Him who is able to do exceeding abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that works within us,

<sup>21</sup> to Him *be* the glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all generations forever and ever. Amen.

**Ephesians 5:18** ... do not get drunk with wine, for that is dissipation, but be filled with the Spirit,

<sup>19</sup> speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody with your heart to the Lord;

<sup>20</sup> always giving thanks for all things in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to God, even the Father;

<sup>21</sup> and be subject to one another in the fear of Christ.

**Colossians 4:2** Devote yourselves to prayer, keeping alert in it with *an attitude of* thanksgiving;

<sup>3</sup> praying at the same time for us as well, that God may open up to us a door for the word, so that we may speak forth the mystery of Christ, for which I have also been imprisoned;

<sup>4</sup> in order that I may make it clear in the way I ought to speak.

**Romans 8:26** ... the Spirit also helps our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we should, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for *us* with groanings too deep for words;

<sup>27</sup> and He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because He intercedes for the saints according to *the will of* God.

<sup>28</sup> And we know that God causes all things to work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to *His* purpose.

<sup>29</sup> For whom He foreknew, He also predestined *to become* conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the first-born among many brethren;

**1 Thessalonians 5:19** Rejoice always;

<sup>17</sup> pray without ceasing;

<sup>18</sup> in everything give thanks; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

<sup>19</sup> Do not quench the Spirit;

**Galatians 5:16** ...walk by the Spirit, and you will not carry out the desire of the flesh.

<sup>17</sup> For the flesh sets its desire against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; for these are in opposition to one another, so that you may not do the things that you please.

... <sup>22</sup> the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,

<sup>23</sup> gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.

<sup>24</sup> Now those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.

<sup>25</sup> If we live by the Spirit, let us also walk by the Spirit.

<sup>26</sup> Let us not become boastful, challenging one another, envying one another.

**2 Corinthians 1:8** ...we do not want you to be unaware, brethren, of our affliction which came *to us* in Asia, that we were burdened excessively, beyond our strength, so that we despaired even of life;

<sup>9</sup> indeed, we had the sentence of death within ourselves in order that we should not trust in ourselves, but in God who raises the dead;

<sup>10</sup> who delivered us from so great a *peril of death*, and will deliver *us*, He on whom we have set our hope. And He will yet deliver us,

<sup>11</sup> you also joining in helping us through your prayers, that thanks may be given by many persons on our behalf for the favor bestowed upon us through *the prayers of many*.
