



How to Fight and Pray

1/29/23

1 Timothy 1:18-2:8

¹⁸This command I entrust to you, Timothy, my son,
in accordance with the prophecies previously made concerning you,
that by them you may fight the good fight,
¹⁹keeping faith and a good conscience,
which some have rejected and suffered shipwreck in regard to their faith.
²⁰Among these are Hymenaeus and Alexander,
whom I have delivered over to Satan, (*see 1 Corinthians 15 below*)
so that they may be taught not to blaspheme.

2:1 First of all, then,

I urge that entreaties *and* prayers, petitions *and* thanksgivings, be made
on behalf of all men,
²for kings and all who are in authority,
in order that we may lead a tranquil and quiet life
in all godliness and dignity.
³This is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior,
⁴who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.
⁵For there is one God, *and* one mediator also between God and men,
the man Christ Jesus,
⁶who gave Himself as a ransom for all,
the testimony *borne* at the proper time.

⁷And

for this
I was appointed
a preacher and an apostle
(I am telling the truth, I am not lying)
as a teacher of the Gentiles in faith and truth.
⁸Therefore I want the men in every place to pray,
lifting up holy hands,
without wrath and dissension.

Romans 14:1 Now accept the one who is weak in faith, *but* not for *the purpose of* passing judgment on his opinions.

² One man has faith that he may eat all things, but he who is weak eats vegetables *only*.

³ Let not him who eats regard with contempt him who does not eat, and let not him who does not eat judge him who eats, for God has accepted him.

⁴ Who are you to judge the servant of another? To his own master he stands or falls; and stand he will, for the Lord is able to make him stand.

⁵ One man regards one day above another, another regards every day *alike*. Let each man be fully convinced in his own mind.

Romans 16:17 Now I urge you, brethren, keep your eye on those who cause dissensions and hindrances contrary to the teaching which you learned, and turn away from them.

¹⁸ For such men are slaves, not of our Lord Christ but of their own appetites; and by their smooth and flattering speech they deceive the hearts of the unsuspecting.

1 Corinthians 5:1 It is actually reported that there is immorality among you, and immorality of such a kind as does not exist even among the Gentiles, that someone has his father's wife.

² And you have become arrogant, and have not mourned instead, in order that the one who had done this deed might be removed from your midst.

³ For I, on my part, though absent in body but present in spirit, have already judged him who has so committed this, as though I were present.

⁴ In the name of our Lord Jesus, when you are assembled, and I with you in spirit, with the power of our Lord Jesus,

⁵ *I have decided* to deliver such a one to Satan for the destruction of his flesh, that his spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus.

⁶ Your boasting is not good. Do you not know that a little leaven leavens the whole lump *of dough*?

⁷ Clean out the old leaven, that you may be a new lump...

... ¹¹ I wrote to you not to associate with any so-called brother if he should be an immoral person, or covetous, or an idolater, or a reviler, or a drunkard, or a swindler-- not even to eat with such a one.

¹² For what have I to do with judging outsiders? Do you not judge those who are within *the church*?

¹³ But those who are outside, God judges. Remove the wicked man from among yourselves.

Matthew 6:9 "Pray, then, in this way:

'Our Father who art in heaven,
Hallowed be Thy name.

¹⁰ 'Thy kingdom come.

Thy will be done, On earth as it is in heaven.

¹¹ 'Give us this day our daily bread.

¹² 'And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors.

¹³ 'And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

John 14:8 Philip said to Him, "Lord, show us the Father, and it is enough for us."

⁹ Jesus said to him, "Have I been so long with you, and *yet* you have not come to know Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; how do you say, 'Show us the Father'?"

¹⁰ "Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father is in Me? The words that I say to you I do not speak on My own initiative, but the Father abiding in Me does His works.

¹¹ "Believe Me that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me; otherwise believe on account of the works themselves.

¹² "Truly, truly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater *works* than these shall he do; because I go to the Father.

¹³ "And whatever you ask in My name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

¹⁴ "If you ask Me anything in My name, I will do *it*.

¹⁵ "If you love Me, you will keep My commandments.

¹⁶ "And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may be with you forever;

¹⁷ *that is* the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it does not behold Him or know Him, *but* you know Him because He abides with you, and will be in you.

John 15:7 "If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it shall be done for you.

⁸ "By this is My Father glorified, that you bear much fruit, and so prove to be My disciples.

John 15:16 "You did not choose Me, but I chose you, and appointed you, that you should go and bear fruit, and *that* your fruit should remain, that whatever you ask of the Father in My name, He may give to you.

¹⁷ "This I command you, that you love one another.

¹⁸ "If the world hates you, you know that it has hated Me before *it hated* you.

¹⁹ "If you were of the world, the world would love its own; but because you are not of the world, but I chose you out of the world, therefore the world hates you.

²⁰ "Remember the word that I said to you, 'A slave is not greater than his master.' If they persecuted Me, they will also persecute you; if they kept My word, they will keep yours also.

John 16:1 "These things I have spoken to you, that you may be kept from stumbling.

² "They will make you outcasts from the synagogue, but an hour is coming for everyone who kills you to think that he is offering service to God.

John 16:12 "I have many more things to say to you, but you cannot bear *them* now.

¹³ "But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth; for He will not speak on His own initiative, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you what is to come.

¹⁴ "He shall glorify Me; for He shall take of Mine, and shall disclose *it* to you.

¹⁵ "All things that the Father has are Mine; therefore I said, that He takes of Mine, and will disclose *it* to you.

John 16:23 "And in that day you will ask Me no question. Truly, truly, I say to you, if you shall ask the Father for anything, He will give it to you in My name.

²⁴ "Until now you have asked for nothing in My name; ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be made full.

²⁵ "These things I have spoken to you in figurative language; an hour is coming when I will speak no more to you in figurative language, but will tell you plainly of the Father.

²⁶ "In that day you will ask in My name, and I do not say to you that I will request the Father on your behalf;

²⁷ for the Father Himself loves you, because you have loved Me, and have believed that I came forth from the Father.

John 16:33 "These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you have tribulation, but take courage; I have overcome the world."

John 17:11 ...Holy Father, keep them in Thy name, *the name* which Thou hast given Me, that they may be one, even as *We are*.

John 17:15 "I do not ask Thee to take them out of the world, but to keep them from the evil *one*.

John 17:17 "Sanctify them in the truth; Thy word is truth.

John 17:20 "I do not ask in behalf of these alone, but for those also who believe in Me through their word;

²¹ that they may all be one; even as Thou, Father, *art* in Me, and I in Thee, that they also may be in Us; that the world may believe that Thou didst send Me.

²² "And the glory which Thou hast given Me I have given to them; that they may be one, just as *We are one*;

²³ I in them, and Thou in Me, that they may be perfected in unity, that the world may know that Thou didst send Me, and didst love them, even as Thou didst love Me.

²⁴ "Father, I desire that they also, whom Thou hast given Me, be with Me where I am, in order that they may behold My glory, which Thou hast given Me; for Thou didst love Me before the foundation of the world.

All scripture is from the NASV. 1Timothy 1:18-2:8 is in the form of a phrase by phrase break down. Matthew 6:9-13 is presented phrase by phrase. The words and word order have not been changed in any passage.
