

# *Dinner Get-Togethers* Share a Meal Get to Know Someone New


We'd like to offer those who frequently attend CPF a chance to get better acquainted. Our Fellowship and Member Services teams will help pair you up with another family.

**Proverbs 1:8** Hear, my son, your father's instruction, And <u>do not forsake your mother's teaching;</u> <sup>9</sup> Indeed, they are a graceful wreath to your head, And ornaments about your neck.

**Proverbs 6:20** My son, observe the commandment of your father, And <u>do not forsake the teaching of your mother;</u>

<sup>21</sup> Bind them continually on your heart; Tie them around your neck.

<sup>22</sup> When you walk about, they will guide you; When you sleep, they will watch over you; And when you awake, they will talk to you.

<sup>23</sup> For the commandment is a lamp, and the teaching is light; And reproofs for discipline are the way of life,

**Proverbs 10:1** ... A <u>wise</u> son makes a father glad, But a foolish son is a grief to his mother.

Proverbs 15:20 A <u>wise</u> son makes a father glad, But a foolish man despises his mother.

**Proverbs 29:15** <u>The rod and reproof give wisdom</u>, But a child who gets his own way brings shame to his mother.

Proverbs 31:1 The words of King Lemuel, the oracle which his mother taught him.

<sup>2</sup> What, O my son? And what, O son of my womb? And what, O son of my vows?

<sup>3</sup> Do not give your strength to women, Or your ways to that which destroys kings.

<sup>4</sup> It is not for kings, O Lemuel, It is not for kings to drink wine, Or for rulers to desire strong drink,

<sup>5</sup> Lest they drink and forget what is decreed, And pervert the rights of all the afflicted.

...<sup>10</sup> An excellent wife, who can find?...

...<sup>25</sup> Strength and dignity are her clothing, And she smiles at the future.

<sup>26</sup> She opens her mouth in wisdom, And the teaching of kindness is on her tongue.

<sup>27</sup> She looks well to the ways of her household, And does not eat the bread of idleness.

<sup>28</sup> Her children rise up and bless her; Her husband *also*, and he praises her, *saying*:

<sup>29</sup> "Many daughters have done nobly, But you excel them all."

<sup>30</sup> Charm is deceitful and beauty is vain,

But a woman who fears the LORD, she shall be praised.

<sup>31</sup> Give her the product of her hands, And let her works praise her in the gates.

**James 3:13** Who among you is wise and understanding? Let him show by his good behavior his deeds in <u>the gentleness of wisdom</u>.

<sup>14</sup> But if you have bitter jealousy and selfish ambition in your heart, do not be arrogant and *so* lie against the truth.

<sup>15</sup> This wisdom is not that which comes down from above, but is earthly, natural, demonic.

<sup>16</sup> For where jealousy and selfish ambition exist, there is disorder and every evil thing.

<sup>17</sup> But the wisdom from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, reasonable, full of mercy and good fruits, unwavering, without hypocrisy.

<sup>18</sup> And the seed whose fruit is righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace.

**4:1** What is the source of quarrels and conflicts among you? Is not the source your pleasures that wage war in your members?

<sup>2</sup> You lust and do not have; *so* you commit murder. And you are envious and cannot obtain; *so* you fight and quarrel. You do not have because you do not ask.

<sup>3</sup> You ask and do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives, so that you may spend *it* on your pleasures.

<sup>4</sup> You adulteresses, do you not know that friendship with the world is hostility toward God? Therefore whoever wishes to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.

<sup>5</sup> Or do you think that the Scripture speaks to no purpose: "He jealously desires the Spirit which He has made to dwell in us"?

<sup>6</sup> But He gives a greater grace. Therefore *it* says, "God is opposed to the proud, but gives grace to the humble."

<sup>7</sup> Submit therefore to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

<sup>8</sup> Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded.

<sup>9</sup> Be miserable and mourn and weep; let your laughter be turned into mourning, and your joy to gloom.
<sup>10</sup> <u>Humble yourselves in the presence of the Lord</u>, and He will exalt you.

**1** Corinthians 13:4 <u>Love</u> is patient, love is kind, *and* is not jealous; love does not brag *and* is not arrogant,

<sup>5</sup> does not act unbecomingly; it does not seek its own, is not provoked, does not take into account a wrong *suffered*,

<sup>6</sup> does not rejoice in unrighteousness, but rejoices with the truth;

<sup>7</sup> bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.

<sup>8</sup> Love never fails;

**1 Peter 3:7** You husbands likewise, live with *your wives* in an understanding way, as with a weaker vessel, since she is a woman; and grant her <u>honor</u> as a fellow heir of the grace of life, so that your prayers may not be hindered.

<sup>8</sup> To sum up, let all be harmonious, sympathetic, brotherly, kindhearted, and humble in spirit;

<sup>9</sup> not returning evil for evil, or insult for insult, but giving a blessing instead; for you were called for the very purpose that you might inherit a blessing.

<sup>10</sup> For, "Let him who means to love life and see good days Refrain his tongue from evil and his lips from speaking guile.

<sup>11</sup> "And let him turn away from evil and do good; Let him seek peace and pursue it.

<sup>12</sup> "For the eyes of the Lord are upon the righteous, And His ears attend to their prayer, But the face of the Lord is against those who do evil."

**Colossians 3:1** If then you have been raised up with Christ, keep seeking the things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God.

<sup>2</sup> <u>Set your mind on the things above</u>, not on the things that are on earth.

<sup>3</sup> For you have died and your life is hidden with Christ in God.

<sup>4</sup> When Christ, who is our life, is revealed, then you also will be revealed with Him in glory.

<sup>5</sup> Therefore consider the members of your earthly body as dead to immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and greed, which amounts to idolatry.

<sup>6</sup> For it is on account of these things that the wrath of God will come,

<sup>7</sup> and in them you also once walked, when you were living in them.

<sup>8</sup> But now you also, put them all aside: anger, wrath, malice, slander, *and* abusive speech from your mouth.

<sup>9</sup> Do not lie to one another, since you laid aside the old self with its *evil* practices,

<sup>10</sup> and have put on the new self who is being renewed to a true knowledge according to the image of the One who created him

<sup>11</sup> -- *a renewal* in which there is no *distinction between* Greek and Jew, circumcised and uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave and freeman, but Christ is all, and in all.

<sup>12</sup> And so, as those who have been chosen of God, holy and beloved, put on a heart of compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience;

<sup>13</sup> bearing with one another, and forgiving each other, whoever has a complaint against anyone; just as the Lord forgave you, so also should you.

<sup>14</sup> And beyond all these things *put on* love, which is the perfect bond of unity.

<sup>15</sup> And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body; and be thankful.

<sup>16</sup> Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you, with all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another with psalms *and* hymns *and* spiritual songs, singing with thankfulness in your hearts to God.

<sup>17</sup> And whatever you do in word or deed, *do* all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through Him to God the Father.

<sup>18</sup> Wives, be subject to your husbands, as is fitting in the Lord.

<sup>19</sup> Husbands, love your wives, and do not be embittered against them.

<sup>20</sup> Children, be obedient to your parents in all things, for this is well-pleasing to the Lord.

<sup>21</sup> Fathers, do not exasperate your children, that they may not lose heart.

**Philippians 2:1** If therefore there is any encouragement in Christ, if there is any consolation of love, if there is any fellowship of the Spirit, if any affection and compassion,

<sup>2</sup> make my joy complete by being of the same mind, maintaining the same love, united in spirit, intent on one purpose.

<sup>3</sup> Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind let each of you regard one another as more important than himself;

<sup>4</sup> do not *merely* look out for your own personal interests, but also for the interests of others.

<sup>5</sup> Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus,

<sup>6</sup> who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, 7 but any tight line of taking the form of a band convert.

<sup>7</sup> but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant...
