**2 Timothy 1:3** I thank God, whom I serve with a clear conscience the way my forefathers did, as I constantly remember you in my prayers night and day,...

### Instruction

2 Timothy 1:6 ...kindle afresh the gift of God which is in you...

**2 Timothy 1:8** Therefore do not be ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, or of me His prisoner; but join with *me* in suffering for the gospel according to the power of God,...

**2 Timothy 1:13** <u>Retain the standard of sound words</u> which you have heard from me, in the faith and love which are in Christ Jesus.

**2 Timothy 1:14** <u>Guard, through the Holy Spirit who dwells in us, the treasure</u> which has been entrusted to *you*.

# 2 Timothy 2

You therefore, my son,

be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus.

<sup>2</sup>And

the things which you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses, these entrust to faithful men,

who will be able to teach others also.

<sup>3</sup>Suffer hardship with me, as a good soldier of Christ Jesus.

<sup>4</sup>No soldier in active service entangles himself in the affairs of everyday life, so that he may please the one who enlisted him as a soldier.

<sup>5</sup>And also

if anyone competes as an athlete, he does not win the prize unless he competes according to the rules.

<sup>6</sup>The hard-working farmer ought to be the first to receive his share of the crops. <sup>7</sup>Consider what I say,

for the Lord will give you understanding in everything.

<sup>8</sup>Remember Jesus Christ,

risen from the dead,

descendant of David,

according to my gospel,

<sup>9</sup>for which I suffer hardship even to imprisonment as a criminal;

but

the word of God is not imprisoned.

<sup>10</sup>For this reason I endure all things

for the sake of those who are chosen,

that they also may obtain the salvation

which is in Christ Jesus

and with it eternal glory.

<sup>11</sup>It is a trustworthy statement:

For if we died with Him, we shall also live with Him;

<sup>12</sup>If we endure, we shall also reign with Him;

If we deny Him, He also will deny us;

<sup>13</sup>If we are faithless, He remains faithful; for He cannot deny Himself.

<sup>14</sup>Remind them of these things,

<u>and</u>

solemnly charge them

in the presence of God

not to wrangle about words,

which is useless, and leads to the ruin of the hearers.

## <sup>15</sup>Be diligent to present yourself approved to God

as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, handling accurately the word of truth.

<sup>16</sup>But

avoid worldly and empty chatter,

for

it will lead to further ungodliness,

<sup>17</sup>and

their talk will spread like gangrene.

Among them are Hymenaeus and Philetus,

<sup>18</sup>*men* who have gone astray from the truth

saying that the resurrection has already taken place,

and thus they upset the faith of some.

<sup>19</sup>Nevertheless, the firm foundation of God stands, having this seal,

"The Lord knows those who are His,"

and,

"Let everyone who names the name of the Lord <u>abstain from wickedness</u>." <sup>20</sup>Now

in a large house there are

not only gold and silver vessels,

but also vessels of wood and of earthenware,

and some to honor and some to dishonor.

<sup>21</sup>Therefore,

if a man cleanses himself from these things,

he will be

a vessel for honor,

sanctified,

useful to the Master,

prepared for every good work.

<sup>22</sup>Now

flee from youthful lusts, and pursue <u>righteousness,</u> <u>faith,</u> <u>love</u> <u>and peace,</u> with those who call on the Lord from a pure heart.

## <sup>23</sup>But

refuse foolish and ignorant speculations,

knowing that they produce quarrels.

<sup>24</sup>And the Lord's bond-servant must not be quarrelsome,

but be

kind to all,

able to teach,

patient when wronged,

<sup>25</sup>with gentleness correcting those who are in opposition,

if perhaps

God may grant them repentance

leading to the knowledge of the truth,

<sup>26</sup>and

they may come to their senses

and

escape from the snare of the devil,

having been held captive by him to do his will.
