Worship with new songs (and old)

Psalm 33:3 Sing to Him **a new song**; Play skillfully with a shout of joy.

Psalm 96:1 Sing to the LORD a new song; Sing to the LORD, all the earth.

Psalm 98:1 O Sing to the LORD **a new song**, For He has done wonderful things...

Psalm 149:1 ... Sing to the LORD **a new song**, And His praise in the congregation of the godly ones.

Worship with a humble posture
