If the Lord has laid another area of service on your heart, please contact an elder or the church office.

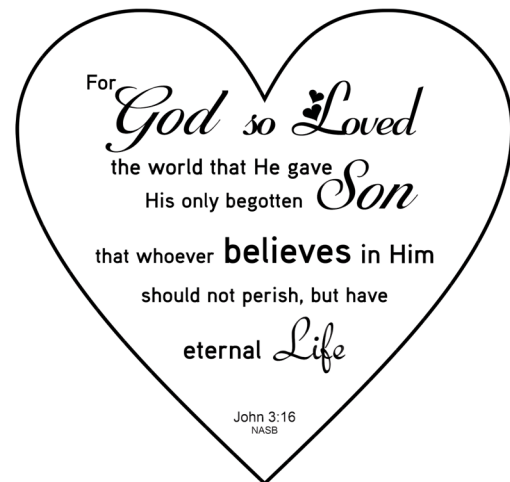
Called Business Meeting TODAY
