# How to Love God

1/19/25

**Matthew 22:36** "Teacher, which is the great commandment in the Law?"

<sup>37</sup> And He said to him, "'You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind.'

<sup>38</sup> "This is the great and foremost commandment.

<sup>39</sup> "The second is like it, 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.'

<sup>40</sup> "On these two commandments depend the whole Law and the Prophets."

## *How to love God*

1. *Meditate on the infinite love of Jesus*

**John 15:9** "Just as the Father has loved Me, I have also loved you; abide in My love. (see also John 17:22-26)

2. *Meditate on the infinite love of God in the gospel*

**Romans 5:8** But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. (see Romans 5:1-11)

a. *God loves you infinitely in adversity*

**Romans 8:38** For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers,  
<sup>39</sup> nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord. (see Romans 8:15-39)

b. *God loved you infinitely in eternity past*

**Ephesians 1:3** Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly *places* in Christ,  
<sup>4</sup> just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before Him. In love  
<sup>5</sup> He predestined us to adoption as sons through Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the kind intention of His will,  
<sup>6</sup> to the praise of the glory of His grace, which He freely bestowed on us in the Beloved.

<sup>7</sup> In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace,  
<sup>8</sup> which He lavished upon us.

c. *God loved you infinitely when you were in rebellion*

**Ephesians 2:1** And you were dead in your trespasses and sins,  
<sup>2</sup> in which you formerly walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, of the spirit that is now working in the sons of disobedience.  
<sup>3</sup> Among them we too all formerly lived in the lusts of our flesh, indulging the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, even as the rest.  
<sup>4</sup> But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us,  
<sup>5</sup> even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved),

d. *God loves you infinitely now*

<sup>6</sup> and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly *places*, in Christ Jesus,

e. *God will love you infinitely for all eternity*

<sup>7</sup> in order that in the ages to come He might show the surpassing riches of His grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.  
<sup>8</sup> For by grace you have been saved ...

3. Pray for e \_\_\_\_\_ to comprehend God's infinite love

**Ephesians 3:16** ...*(I pray)* that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with power through His Spirit in the inner man;  
<sup>17</sup> so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; *and* that you, being rooted and grounded in love,  
<sup>18</sup> may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth,  
<sup>19</sup> and to know the love of Christ which surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled up to all the fulness of God.

4. I \_\_\_\_\_ God's infinite love toward His family

**Ephesians 5:1** Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children;  
<sup>2</sup> and walk in love, just as Christ also loved you, and gave Himself up for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God as a fragrant aroma.

**Ephesians 5:25** Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her;  
<sup>26</sup> that He might sanctify her...

**Ephesians 6:24** Grace be with all those who love our Lord Jesus Christ with a love incorruptible.

**1 John 4:7** Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God.

<sup>8</sup> The one who does not love does not know God, for God is love.

<sup>9</sup> By this the love of God was manifested in us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world so that we might live through Him.

<sup>10</sup> In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins.

<sup>11</sup> Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another.

<sup>12</sup> No one has beheld God at any time; if we love one another, God abides in us, and His love is perfected in us.

5. D what you d \_\_\_\_\_ when you loved God

**Revelation 2:1** "To the angel of the church in Ephesus write: The One who holds the seven stars in His right hand, the One who walks among the seven golden lampstands, says this:

<sup>2</sup> 'I know your deeds and your toil and perseverance, and that you cannot endure evil men, and you put to the test those who call themselves apostles, and they are not, and you found them *to be* false;

<sup>3</sup> and you have perseverance and have endured for My name's sake, and have not grown weary.

<sup>4</sup> 'But I have *this* against you, that you have left your first love.

<sup>5</sup> 'Remember therefore from where you have fallen, and repent and do the deeds you did at first; or else I am coming to you, and will remove your lampstand out of its place-- unless you repent.

6. Prioritize undistracted d \_\_\_\_\_ time with God

**Luke 10:38** Now as they were traveling along, He entered a certain village; and a woman named Martha welcomed Him into her home.

<sup>39</sup> And she had a sister called Mary, who moreover was listening to the Lord's word, seated at His feet.

<sup>40</sup> But Martha was distracted with all her preparations; and she came up *to Him*, and said, "Lord, do You not care that my sister has left me to do all the serving alone? Then tell her to help me."

<sup>41</sup> But the Lord answered and said to her, "Martha, Martha, you are worried and bothered about so many things;

<sup>42</sup> but *only* a few things are necessary, really *only* one, for Mary has chosen the good part, which shall not be taken away from her."
