

2 Peter 2:1 But false prophets also arose among the people, just as there will also be false teachers among you, who will **secretly** introduce destructive **heresies**, even **denying the Master** who bought them, bringing swift destruction upon themselves. ² Many will follow their **sensuality**, and because of them the way of **the truth will be maligned**; ³ and in *their* **greed** they will **exploit** you with **false words**; their judgment from long ago is not idle, and their destruction is not asleep.

⁴ For if God did not spare angels when they sinned, but cast them into hell and committed them to pits of darkness, reserved for judgment; ⁵ and did not spare the ancient world, but preserved Noah, a preacher of righteousness, with seven others, when He brought a flood upon the world of the ungodly; ⁶ and *if* He condemned the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah to destruction by reducing *them* to ashes, having made them an example to those who would live ungodly *lives* thereafter; ⁷ and *if* He rescued righteous Lot, oppressed by the sensual conduct of unprincipled men ⁸ (for by what he saw and heard *that* righteous man, while living among them, felt *his* righteous soul tormented day after day by *their* lawless deeds), ⁹ *then* the Lord knows how to rescue the godly from temptation, and to keep the unrighteous under punishment for the day of judgment,

¹⁰ and especially those who **indulge the flesh** in *its* corrupt desires and **despise authority**. **daring**, **self-willed**, they do not tremble when they **revile angelic majesties**, ¹¹ whereas angels who are greater in might and power do not bring a reviling judgment against them before the Lord. ¹² But these, like unreasoning animals, born as creatures of instinct to be captured and killed, **reviling where they have no knowledge**, will in the destruction of those creatures also be destroyed, ¹³ suffering wrong as the wages of doing wrong. They count it a pleasure to **revel in the daytime**. They are stains and blemishes, **reveling in their deceptions**, as they **carouse with you**, ¹⁴ having **eyes full of adultery**

that **never cease from sin**, **enticing unstable souls**, having a heart trained in **greed**, accursed children; ¹⁵ forsaking the right way, they have **gone astray**, having **followed the way of Balaam**, the *son* of Beor, who loved the wages of unrighteousness; ¹⁶ but he received a rebuke for his own transgression, *for* a mute donkey, speaking with a voice of a man, restrained the madness of the prophet.

¹⁷ These are springs without water and mists driven by a storm, for whom the black darkness has been reserved. ¹⁸ For speaking out **arrogant** *words* **of vanity** they **entice by fleshly desires**, by sensuality, those who barely escape from the ones who live in error, ¹⁹ promising them freedom while they themselves are **slaves of corruption**; for by what a man is overcome, by this he is enslaved.

The breeding of dogs and hogs

²⁰ For if, after **they have escaped the defilements of the world** by the knowledge of the Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, **they are again entangled in them and are overcome**, the last state has become worse for them than the first. ²¹ For it would be better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than having known it, to turn away from the holy commandment handed on to them. ²² It has happened to them according to the true proverb, "A dog returns to its own vomit," and. "A sow, after washing, *returns* to wallowing in the mire."

Philippians 2:2 Beware of the dogs, beware of the evil workers, beware of the false circumcision; ³ for we are the *true* circumcision, who worship in the Spirit of God and glory in Christ Jesus and put no confidence in the flesh,

Acts 20:27 ...I did not shrink from declaring to you the whole purpose of God. ²⁸ Be on guard for yourselves and for all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood. ²⁹ I know that after my departure savage wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock; ³⁰ and from among your own selves men will arise, speaking perverse things, to draw away the disciples after them. ³¹ Therefore be on the alert, remembering that night and day for a period of three years I did not cease to admonish each one with tears. ³² And now I commend you to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build *you* up and to give *you* the inheritance among all those who are sanctified.

Matthew 24:11 Many false prophets will arise and will mislead many. ¹² Because lawlessness is increased, most people's love will grow cold

2 John 1:9 Anyone who goes too far and does not abide in the teaching of Christ, does not have God; the one who abides in the teaching, he has both the Father and the Son. ¹⁰ If anyone comes to you and does not bring this teaching, do not receive him into *your* house, and do not give him a greeting; ¹¹ for the one who gives him a greeting participates in his evil deeds.

Galatians 1:6 I am amazed that you are so quickly deserting Him who called you by the grace of Christ, for a different gospel; ⁷ which is *really* not another; only there are some who are disturbing you and want to distort the gospel of Christ. ⁸ But even if we, or an angel from heaven, should preach to you a gospel contrary to what we have preached to you, he is to be accursed! ⁹ As we have said before, so I say again now, if any man is preaching to you a gospel contrary to what you received, he is to be accursed!
