The Rest We Desire

Psalm 23:1 The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want.

² He makes me lie down in green pastures; He leads me beside quiet waters.

³ He restores my soul; He guides me in the paths of righteousness
For His name's sake.

⁴ Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I fear no evil,
for You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me.

⁵ You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies;
You have anointed my head with oil; My cup overflows.

⁶ Surely goodness and lovingkindness will follow me all the days of my life,
And I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever.

Matthew 11:28 "Come to Me, all who are weary and heavy-laden, and I will give you rest.

²⁹ Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart,
and you will find rest for your souls.

³⁰ For My yoke is easy and My burden is light."

Sabbath Rest in The New Testament

Colossians 2:16 ...no one is to act as your judge in regard to food or drink or in respect to a festival or a new moon or a Sabbath day—

¹⁷ things which are a *mere* shadow of what is to come; but the substance belongs to Christ.

Galatians 4:9 ...how is it that you turn back again to the weak and worthless elemental things, to which you desire to be enslaved all over again?

¹⁰ You observe days and months and seasons and years.

¹¹ I fear for you, that perhaps I have labored over you in vain.

Romans 14:5 One person regards one day above another, another regards every day *alike*. Each person must be fully convinced in his own mind.

How to Enter God's Rest

Hebrews 3

⁷ Therefore, just as the Holy Spirit says,

“Today if you hear His voice,

⁸ Do not harden your hearts as when they provoked Me,
As in the day of trial in the wilderness,

⁹ Where your fathers tried Me by testing Me,
And saw My works for forty years.

¹⁰ “Therefore I was angry with this generation,
And said, ‘They always go astray in their heart,
And they did not know My ways’;

¹¹ As I swore in My wrath,

‘ They shall not enter **My rest.**’” (Psalm 95:7-11, a song about Exodus 17:1-7)

¹² Take care, brethren, that there not be in any one of you an evil, unbelieving heart that falls away from the living God.

¹³ But encourage one another day after day, as long as it is *still* called “Today,” so that none of you will be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin.

¹⁴ For we have become partakers of Christ, if we hold fast the beginning of our assurance firm until the end,

¹⁵ while it is said,

“Today if you hear His voice,

Do not harden your hearts, as when they provoked Me.”

¹⁶ For who provoked *Him* when they had heard? Indeed, did not all those who came out of Egypt *led* by Moses?

¹⁷ And with whom was He angry for forty years? Was it not with those who sinned, whose bodies fell in the wilderness?

¹⁸ And to whom did He swear that they would not enter **His rest**, but to those who were disobedient?

¹⁹ So we see that they were not able to enter because of unbelief.

Hebrews 4 Therefore, let us fear if, while a promise remains of entering His rest, any one of you may seem to have come short of it.

² For indeed we have had good news preached to us, just as they also; but the word they heard did not profit them, because it was not united by faith in those who heard.

³ For we who have believed enter that rest, just as He has said, “As I swore in My wrath, They shall not enter My rest,” although His works were finished from the foundation of the world.

⁴ For He has said somewhere concerning the seventh *day*:

“And God rested on the seventh day from all His works”;

⁵ and again in this *passage*, “They shall not enter **My rest**.”

⁶ Therefore, since it remains for some to enter it, and those who formerly had good news preached to them failed to enter because of disobedience,

⁷ He again fixes a certain day, “Today,” saying through David after so long a time just as has been said before,

“Today if you hear His voice, Do not harden your hearts.”

⁸ For if Joshua had given them rest, He would not have spoken of another day after that.

⁹ So there remains a Sabbath rest for the people of God.

¹⁰ For the one who has entered His rest has himself also rested from his works, as God did from His.

¹¹ Therefore let us be diligent to enter that rest, so that no one will fall, through *following* the same example of disobedience.

¹² For the word of God is living and active and sharper than any two edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

¹³ And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things are open and laid bare to the eyes of Him with whom we have to do.

¹⁴ Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession.

¹⁵ For we do not have a high priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but One who has been tempted in all things as *we are*, yet without sin.

¹⁶ Therefore let us draw near with confidence to the throne of grace, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.
