Hebrews 7:22 ...Jesus has become the guarantee of a better covenant.

²³The former priests, on the one hand, existed in greater numbers because they were prevented by death from continuing,

²⁴but Jesus, on the other hand, because He continues forever, holds His priesthood permanently.

²⁵Therefore **He is able also to save forever those who draw near to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.**

²⁶For it was fitting for us to have such a high priest, holy, innocent, undefiled, separated from sinners and exalted above the heavens;

²⁷who does not need daily, like those high priests, to offer up sacrifices, first for His own sins and then for the sins of the people, because this He did once for all when He offered up Himself.

²⁸For the Law appoints men as high priests who are weak, but the word of the oath (*Psalms 110:4*), which came after the Law, appoints a Son, made perfect forever.

8:1 Now **the main point** in what has been said is this:

we have such a high priest, who has taken His seat at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens,

²a minister in the sanctuary and in the true tabernacle, which the Lord pitched, not man.

³For every high priest is appointed to offer both gifts and sacrifices; so it is necessary that this high priest also have something to offer.

⁴Now if He were on earth, He would not be a priest at all, since there are those who offer the gifts according to the Law;

⁵who serve a copy and shadow of the heavenly things, just as Moses was warned by God when he was about to erect the tabernacle; for, "See," He says, "that you make all things according to the pattern which was shown you on the mountain."

⁶But now He has obtained a more excellent ministry, by as much as He is also the mediator of a better covenant, which has been enacted on better promises.

⁷For if that first covenant had been faultless, there would have been no occasion sought for a second.

⁸For finding fault with them, He says,

“Behold, days are coming, says the Lord,

When I will effect a new covenant

With the house of Israel and with the house of Judah;

⁹Not like the covenant which I made with their fathers

On the day when I took them by the hand

To lead them out of the land of Egypt;

For they did not continue in My covenant,

And I did not care for them, says the Lord.

¹⁰“For **this is the covenant** that I will make with the house of Israel

After those days, says the Lord:

1 I will put My laws into their minds, And I will write them on their hearts.

2 And I will be their God, And they shall be My people.

3 ¹¹“And they shall not teach everyone his fellow citizen,
And everyone his brother, saying, ‘Know the Lord,’
For all will know Me, From the least to the greatest of them.

4 ¹²“For I will be merciful to their iniquities,
And I will remember their sins no more.” (Jeremiah 31:31-34)

¹³When He said, “A new covenant,” He has made the first obsolete. But whatever is becoming obsolete and growing old is ready to disappear.

#1 I will put My laws into their minds, And I will write them on their hearts.

Hebrews 8:10

Ezekiel 36:24 "For I will take you from the nations, gather you from all the lands and bring you into your own land.

²⁵"Then I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean; I will cleanse you from all your filthiness and from all your idols.

²⁶"Moreover, I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; and I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh.

²⁷"I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will be careful to observe My ordinances.

²⁸"You will live in the land that I gave to your forefathers; so you will be My people, and I will be your God.

Ephesians 4:22 ...in reference to your former manner of life, you lay aside the old self, which is being corrupted in accordance with the lusts of deceit,

²³and that you be renewed in the spirit of your mind,

²⁴and put on the new self, which in the likeness of God has been created in righteousness and holiness of the truth.

²⁵Therefore, laying aside falsehood, speak truth each one of you with his neighbor, for we are members of one another.

#2 And I will be their God, And they shall be My people. Hebrews 8:10

Matthew 6:9 "Pray, then, in this way: 'Our Father ...

Galatians 4:4 ...when the fullness of the time came, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the Law,

⁵so that He might redeem those who were under the Law, that we might receive the adoption as sons.

⁶Because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!"

#3 ¹¹“And they shall not teach everyone his fellow citizen,
And everyone his brother, saying, ‘Know the Lord,’
For all will know Me, From the least to the greatest of them. Hebrews 8:11

John 14:26 ...the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I said to you.

1 John 2:27 As for you, the anointing which you received from Him abides in you, and you have no need for anyone to teach you; but as His anointing teaches you about all things, and is true and is not a lie, and just as it has taught you, you abide in Him.

#4 ¹²“For I will be merciful to their iniquities,
And I will remember their sins no more.” Hebrews 8:12

Galatians 3:13 Christ redeemed us from the curse of the Law, having become a curse for us—for it is written, “Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree”—
¹⁴in order that in Christ Jesus the blessing of Abraham might come to the Gentiles, so that we would receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

Colossians 2:13 When you were dead in your transgressions and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He made you alive together with Him, having forgiven us all our transgressions,
¹⁴having canceled out the certificate of debt consisting of decrees against us, which was hostile to us; and He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross.
