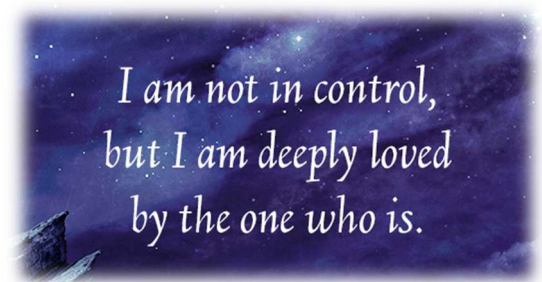

Hebrews 8:8-11 (quoted from **Jeremiah 31:31-34**

This quote is located in the boxes)

“...Behold, days are coming, says the Lord,
When I will effect a new covenant
With the house of Israel and with the house of Judah;
⁹Not like the covenant which I made with their fathers
On the day when I took them by the hand
To lead them out of the land of Egypt;
For they did not continue in My covenant,
And I did not care for them, says the Lord.
¹⁰“For **this is the covenant** that I will make with the house of Israel
After those days, says the Lord:

#1 I will put My laws into their minds, And I will write them on their hearts.

Deuteronomy 6:4 “Hear, O Israel! The Lord is our God, the Lord is one!

⁵“You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might.

⁶“These words, which I am commanding you today, shall be on your heart.

Ezekiel 36:26 “Moreover, I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; and I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh.

²⁷“I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will be careful to observe My ordinances.

²⁸“You will live in the land that I gave to your forefathers; so you will be My people, and I will be your God.

Ephesians 2:3 ...(*we*) were by nature children of wrath, even as the rest.

⁴But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us,

⁵even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved),

⁶and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus,

⁷so that in the ages to come He might show the surpassing riches of His grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.

Ephesians 4:22 ...in reference to your former manner of life, you lay aside the old self, which is being corrupted in accordance with the lusts of deceit,
²³and that you be renewed in the spirit of your mind,
²⁴and put on the new self, which in the likeness of God has been created in righteousness and holiness of the truth.
²⁵Therefore, laying aside falsehood, speak truth each one of you with his neighbor, for we are members of one another. (Most of the rest of Ephesians is the application of Old Testament laws for our lives)

#2 And I will be their God, And they shall be My people. Hebrews 8:10

2 Corinthians 6:16 what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For we are the temple of the living God; just as God said, "I will dwell in them and walk among them;

And I will be their God, and they shall be My people". (The underlined quote is called by theologians, "The Covenant Formula," and is found in Leviticus 26:11-12; Ezekiel 37:27 and Jeremiah 31:33. Similar phrases in Exodus 6:7; Jeremiah 7:23; 11:14; 11:20; 24:27; 30:22; 32:38; Ezekiel 14:11; 36:28; 37:23; Zechariah 8:8)

Ezekiel 37:26 (context: Valley of Dry Bones) I will make a covenant of peace with them; it will be an everlasting covenant with them. And I will place them and multiply them, and will set My sanctuary in their midst forever.

²⁷"My dwelling place also will be with them; and I will be their God, and they will be My people."

Galatians 4:4 ...when the fullness of the time came, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the Law,

⁵so that He might redeem those who were under the Law, that we might receive the adoption as sons.

⁶Because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!"

Romans 8:14 all who are being led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God.

¹⁵For you have not received a spirit of slavery leading to fear again, but you have received a spirit of adoption as sons by which we cry out, "Abba! Father!"

¹⁶The Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit that we are children of God,

¹⁷and if children, heirs also, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him so that we may also be glorified with Him.

Matthew 6:9 “Pray, then, in this way: ‘Our Father ...

Revelation 21:3 ... “Behold, the tabernacle of God is among men, and He will dwell among them, and they shall be His people, and God Himself will be among them,

#3 ¹¹ “And they shall not teach everyone his fellow citizen, And everyone his brother, saying, ‘Know the Lord,’ For all will know Me, From the least to the greatest of them. Hebrews 8:11

1 Peter 2:9 ... you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for God’s own possession, so that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;

¹⁰for you once were not a people, but now you are the people of God

Ephesians 4:11 And He gave some as apostles, and some as prophets, and some as evangelists, and some as pastors and teachers,

¹²for the equipping of the saints for the work of service, to the building up of the body of Christ;

¹³until we all attain to the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a mature man, to the measure of the stature which belongs to the fullness of Christ.

¹⁴As a result, we are no longer to be children, tossed here and there by waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, by craftiness in deceitful scheming;

¹⁵but speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in all aspects into Him who is the head, even Christ,

¹⁶from whom the whole body, being fitted and held together by what every joint supplies, according to the proper working of each individual part, causes the growth of the body for the building up of itself in love.

1 John 2:13 I am writing to you, fathers, because you know Him who has been from the beginning... I have written to you, children, because you know the Father.

1 John 2:27 As for you, the anointing which you received from Him abides in you, and you have no need for anyone to teach you; but as His anointing teaches you about all things, and is true and is not a lie, and just as it has taught you, you abide in Him.

#4 ¹²"For I will be merciful to their iniquities, And I will remember their sins no more." Hebrews 8:12

Romans 4:3 ...what does the Scripture say? "Abraham believed God, and it was credited to him as righteousness."

4Now to the one who works, his wage is not credited as a favor, but as what is due.

5But to the one who does not work, but believes in Him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is credited as righteousness

Galatians 3:13 Christ redeemed us from the curse of the Law, having become a curse for us—for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"—

¹⁴in order that in Christ Jesus the blessing of Abraham might come to the Gentiles, so that we would receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

Colossians 2:11 and in Him you were also circumcised with a circumcision made without hands, in the removal of the body of the flesh by the circumcision of Christ;

¹²having been buried with Him in baptism, in which you were also raised up with Him through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead.

¹³When you were dead in your transgressions and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He made you alive together with Him, having forgiven us all our transgressions,

¹⁴having canceled out the certificate of debt consisting of decrees against us, which was hostile to us; and He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross.
