²⁸so Christ also, having been offered once to bear the sins of many, will appear a second time for salvation without reference to sin, to those who eagerly await Him.

2. the urgent need for evangelism, missions and p_____

Luke 13:1 Now on the same occasion there were some present who reported to Him about the Galileans whose blood Pilate had mixed with their sacrifices.

^{2A}nd Jesus said to them, "Do you suppose that these Galileans were greater sinners than all other Galileans because they suffered this fate?

³"I tell you, no, but unless you repent, you will all likewise perish.

⁴"Or do you suppose that those eighteen on whom the tower in Siloam fell and killed them were worse culprits than all the men who live in Jerusalem?

2 Corinthians 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and God of all comfort,

⁴who comforts us in all our affliction so that we will be able to comfort those who are in any affliction with the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted by God.

7. the call to l_____ courageously and alertly

1 Corinthians 16:13 Be on the alert, stand firm in the faith, act like men, be strong.

¹⁴Let all that you do be done in love.

8. the need to i_____ the unimaginable

Romans 1:28 ... just as they did not see fit to acknowledge God any longer, God gave them over to a depraved mind, to do those things which are not proper,

²⁹being filled with all unrighteousness, wickedness, greed, evil; full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, malice; they are gossips,

³⁰slanderers, haters of God, insolent, arrogant, boastful, inventors of evil,...

9. the need to balance justice and f_____

Romans 12:17 Never pay back evil for evil to anyone. Respect what is right in the sight of all men.

¹⁸If possible, so far as it depends on you, be at peace with all men.

¹⁹Never take your own revenge, beloved, but leave room for the wrath of God, for it is written, "Vengeance is Mine, I will repay," says the Lord.

²⁰"But if your enemy is hungry, feed him, and if he is thirsty, give him a drink; for in so doing you will heap burning coals on his head."

²¹Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.

13:1 Every person is to be in subjection to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those which exist are established by God.

²Therefore whoever resists authority has opposed the ordinance of God; and they who have opposed will receive condemnation upon themselves.

³For rulers are not a cause of fear for good behavior, but for evil. Do you want to have no fear of authority? Do what is good and you will have praise from the same;

⁴for it is a minister of God to you for good. But if you do what is evil, be afraid; for it does not bear the sword for nothing; for it is a minister of God, an avenger who brings wrath on the one who practices evil.
